

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
HOUSE BILL 3300**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 13 through 24 and insert:

2 **“SECTION 3. (1) The Public Employees’ Benefit Board may not, di-**  
3 **rectly or through a third party administrator, enter into or renew a**  
4 **contract with a primary care physician, as defined in ORS 442.470, for**  
5 **the payment or reimbursement of claims for services provided to eli-**  
6 **gible employees or family members of eligible employees unless the**  
7 **physician accepts patients who are recipients of medical assistance. A**  
8 **physician is considered to accept patients who are recipients of med-**  
9 **ical assistance if:**

10 **“(a) The physician maintains a patient caseload with a percentage**  
11 **of medical assistance recipients greater than or equal to the percent-**  
12 **age determined by the Oregon Health Authority under section 1 of this**  
13 **2015 Act for the county where the physician’s main office is located;**  
14 **or**

15 **“(b) The physician is willing to accept a number of medical assist-**  
16 **ance patients equal to the number that would satisfy the requirement**  
17 **of paragraph (a) of this subsection but is unable, despite due diligence,**  
18 **to attract enough medical assistance patients to meet the require-**  
19 **ment.**

20 **“(2) Prior to entering into or renewing a contract to provide ser-**  
21 **vices to eligible employees or family members enrolled in a benefit**  
22 **plan offered by the board, the board or a third party administrator**

1 shall require a primary care physician to report, in the manner pre-  
2 scribed by the board, information necessary for the board to determine  
3 if the physician meets the requirements of subsection (1) of this sec-  
4 tion.”.

5 Delete lines 27 through 30 and delete page 2 and insert:

6 **“SECTION 5. (1) The Oregon Educators Benefit Board may not, di-**  
7 **rectly or through a third party administrator, enter into or renew a**  
8 **contract with a primary care physician, as defined in ORS 442.470, for**  
9 **the payment or reimbursement of claims for services provided to eli-**  
10 **gible employees or family members of eligible employees unless the**  
11 **physician accepts patients who are recipients of medical assistance. A**  
12 **physician is considered to accept patients who are recipients of med-**  
13 **ical assistance if:**
