PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 93

- Delete lines 5 through 12 of the printed bill and insert:
- "SECTION 2. (1) A prescription drug benefit program, or a prescription drug benefit offered under a health benefit plan as defined in ORS 743.730, must provide for reimbursement for up to a 90-day supply of a prescription drug dispensed by a pharmacy, as defined in ORS 689.005, if:
- 7 "(a) The prescription drug is covered by the program or plan;
- 8 "(b) The prescription drug has been previously dispensed to the 9 program or plan member with the same dosage instruction for not less 10 than 90 days;
 - "(c) The quantity of the prescription drug dispensed does not exceed the total remaining quantity of the prescription drug that the prescribing practitioner authorized to be dispensed through refills; and
 - "(d) The drug is a generic drug.

- "(2) The coverage required by subsection (1) of this section may be limited by the terms and conditions of a pharmacy network contract, or a prescription drug benefit program or health benefit plan, that are related to the reimbursement rate of the prescription drug.
- "(3) The coverage required by subsection (1) of this section may be limited by formulary restrictions that are related to the prescription drug.
 - "(4) This section does not apply to the reimbursement of pre-

- scription drugs classified as a controlled substance in Schedule II.
- 2 "(5) This section is exempt from ORS 743A.001.".
