On <u>page 1</u> of the printed bill, line 2, after the semicolon delete the rest of the line and insert "creating new provisions; amending ORS 184.483 and 184.484; and declaring an emergency.".

4 On page 5, after line 18, insert:

5 "SECTION 3. (1) The Oregon Department of Administrative Services 6 shall convene a work group to study and make recommendations for 7 updating and modifying the statute laws of this state as necessary to 8 allow the inclusion on the Oregon transparency website of all public 9 notices required by law to be published by public bodies.

"(2) The work group shall be appointed by the Director of the
 Oregon Department of Administrative Services and shall include rep resentatives of:

13 "(a) State agencies;

14 "(b) Local governments; and

15 "(c) The news media.

"(3) Members of the work group are not entitled to compensation
 or reimbursement for expenses and serve as volunteers on the task
 force.

"(4) The department shall submit a report, in the manner provided
 in ORS 192.245, to an appropriate interim committee of the Legislative
 Assembly related to government efficiency no later than January 1,
 2016. The report must describe the results of the deliberations of the

1 work group and may include recommendations for legislation.

2 "(5) As used in this section:

"(a) 'Local government' has the meaning given that term in ORS
174.116.

"(b) 'Public body' has the meaning given that term in ORS 174.109.  $\mathbf{5}$ "(c) 'Public notice' has the meaning given that term in ORS 174.104. 6 "(d) 'State agency' has the meaning given that term in ORS 184.480. 7 "SECTION 4. Section 3 of this 2015 Act is repealed on June 30, 2016. 8 "SECTION 5. The amendments to ORS 184.483 and 184.484 by 9 sections 1 and 2 of this 2015 Act become operative on January 1, 2016. 10 "SECTION 6. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate 11 preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is 12declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect on its passage.". 13
