

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 2472**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 28 through 31.

2 On page 2, delete line 1 and insert:

3 “(2)(a) Subject to paragraphs (c), (d) and (e) of this subsection, the board
4 shall:

5 “(A) Inspect, at least once every two years, the premises and records of
6 funeral establishments, cemeteries, crematoriums, immediate disposition
7 companies and other facilities used for the final disposition of human re-
8 mains and any other location at which human remains may be stored, tem-
9 porarily held or processed prior to final disposition; and

10 “(B) May make random inspections or establish a self-inspection program
11 to supplement inspections required by subparagraph (A) of this paragraph.

12 “(b) The board shall employ one or more persons to perform inspections
13 under this subsection and to aid in the enforcement of the provisions of this
14 chapter and ORS chapters 97 and 432 or rules adopted under this chapter and
15 ORS chapters 97 and 432, except that the board may not employ a person
16 under this paragraph if the person is a member of the board or actively en-
17 gaged in a profession or practice regulated by this chapter.

18 “(c) The board may inspect records under this subsection only to the ex-
19 tent that is necessary to ensure compliance with the provisions of this
20 chapter and ORS chapters 97 and 432 or rules adopted under this chapter or
21 ORS chapters 97 and 432.

22 “(d) The board may not inspect any area used as living quarters under

1 this subsection.

2 “(e) The board may adopt rules setting forth criteria by which an exempt
3 operating cemetery is exempt from inspections described in paragraph (a)(A)
4 of this subsection.”.
