

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 3402**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 4 through 30.

2 On page 2, delete lines 1 through 39 and insert:

3 **“SECTION 1.** ORS 811.111 is amended to read:

4 “811.111. (1) A person commits the offense of violating a speed limit if the
5 person:

6 “(a) Drives a vehicle on an interstate highway, **except for the portions**
7 **of interstate highway described in subsection (2) of this section**, at a
8 speed greater than 65 miles per hour or, if a different speed is posted under
9 ORS 810.180 [(3)], at a speed greater than the posted speed.

10 “(b) Notwithstanding paragraph (a) of this subsection, drives any of the
11 following vehicles at a speed greater than 55 miles per hour on any
12 highway, **except for the portions of highway described in subsections**
13 **(2) to (11) of this section**, or, if a different speed is posted under ORS
14 810.180 [(3)], at a speed greater than the posted speed:

15 “(A) A motor truck with a gross vehicle weight rating of more than 10,000
16 pounds or a truck tractor with a gross vehicle weight rating of more than
17 8,000 pounds.

18 “(B) A school bus.

19 “(C) A school activity vehicle.

20 “(D) A worker transport bus.

21 “(E) A bus operated for transporting children to and from church or an
22 activity or function authorized by a church.

1 “(F) Any vehicle used in the transportation of persons for hire by a
2 nonprofit entity as provided in ORS 825.017 (9).

3 “(c) Drives a vehicle or conveyance on any part of the ocean shore in this
4 state at a speed greater than any of the following:

5 “(A) Any designated speed for ocean shores that is established and posted
6 under ORS 810.180.

7 “(B) If no designated speed is posted under ORS 810.180, 25 miles per
8 hour.

9 “(d) Drives a vehicle upon a highway in any city at a speed greater than
10 a speed posted by authority granted under ORS 810.180 or, if no **designated**
11 speed is posted, the following:

12 “(A) Fifteen miles per hour when driving on an alley or a narrow resi-
13 dential roadway.

14 “(B) Twenty miles per hour in a business district.

15 “(C) Twenty-five miles per hour in a public park.

16 “(D) Twenty-five miles per hour on a highway in a residence district if
17 the highway is not an arterial highway.

18 “(E) Sixty-five miles per hour on an interstate highway.

19 “(F) Fifty-five miles per hour in locations not otherwise described in this
20 paragraph.

21 “(e) Drives a vehicle in a school zone at a speed greater than 20 miles
22 per hour if the school zone is:

23 “(A) A segment of highway described in ORS 801.462 (1)(a) and:

24 “(i) The school zone has a flashing light used as a traffic control device
25 and operated under ORS 810.243 and the flashing light indicates that chil-
26 dren may be arriving at or leaving school; or

27 “(ii) If the school zone does not have a flashing light used as a traffic
28 control device, the person drives in the school zone between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m.
29 on a day when school is in session.

30 “(B) A crosswalk described in ORS 801.462 (1)(b) and:

1 “(i) A flashing light used as a traffic control device and operated under
2 ORS 810.243 indicates that children may be arriving at or leaving school; or

3 “(ii) Children are present, as described in ORS 811.124.

4 **“(2) A person commits the offense of violating a speed limit if the
5 person drives a vehicle on the portion of Interstate 84 beginning at the
6 eastern city limit of The Dalles and ending at the Idaho state line at
7 a speed greater than:**

8 **“(a) Sixty-five miles per hour for vehicles described in subsection
9 (1)(b) of this section; or**

10 **“(b) Seventy miles per hour for all other vehicles.**

11 **“(3) A person commits the offense of violating a speed limit if the
12 person drives a vehicle on the portion of State Highway 95 beginning
13 at the Idaho state line and ending at the Nevada state line at a speed
14 greater than:**

15 **“(a) Sixty-five miles per hour for vehicles described in subsection
16 (1)(b) of this section; or**

17 **“(b) Seventy miles per hour for all other vehicles.**

18 **“(4) A person commits the offense of violating a speed limit if the
19 person drives a vehicle on the portion of State Highway 20 beginning
20 in Bend and ending in Ontario at a speed greater than:**

21 **“(a) Sixty miles per hour for vehicles described in subsection (1)(b)
22 of this section; or**

23 **“(b) Sixty-five miles per hour for all other vehicles.**

24 **“(5) A person commits the offense of violating a speed limit if the
25 person drives a vehicle on the portion of State Highway 197 beginning
26 in The Dalles and ending at its intersection with State Highway 97 and
27 the portion of State Highway 97 beginning at its intersection with
28 State Highway 197 and ending in Klamath Falls at a speed greater
29 than:**

30 **“(a) Sixty miles per hour for vehicles described in subsection (1)(b)**

1 of this section; or

2 “(b) Sixty-five miles per hour for all other vehicles.

3 “(6) A person commits the offense of violating a speed limit if the
4 person drives a vehicle on the portion of State Highway 31 beginning
5 in Valley Falls and ending in La Pine at a speed greater than:

6 “(a) Sixty miles per hour for vehicles described in subsection (1)(b)
7 of this section; or

8 “(b) Sixty-five miles per hour for all other vehicles.

9 “(7) A person commits the offense of violating a speed limit if the
10 person drives a vehicle on the portion of State Highway 78 beginning
11 in Burns Junction and ending in Burns at a speed greater than:

12 “(a) Sixty miles per hour for vehicles described in subsection (1)(b)
13 of this section; or

14 “(b) Sixty-five miles per hour for all other vehicles.

15 “(8) A person commits the offense of violating a speed limit if the
16 person drives a vehicle on the portion of State Highway 395 beginning
17 in Burns and ending in John Day at a speed greater than:

18 “(a) Sixty miles per hour for vehicles described in subsection (1)(b)
19 of this section; or

20 “(b) Sixty-five miles per hour for all other vehicles.

21 “(9) A person commits the offense of violating a speed limit if the
22 person drives a vehicle on the portion of State Highway 395 beginning
23 in Riley and ending at the California state line at a speed greater than:

24 “(a) Sixty miles per hour for vehicles described in subsection (1)(b)
25 of this section; or

26 “(b) Sixty-five miles per hour for all other vehicles.

27 “(10) A person commits the offense of violating a speed limit if the
28 person drives a vehicle on the portion of Oregon Route 205 beginning
29 in Burns and ending in Frenchglen at a speed greater than:

30 “(a) Sixty miles per hour for vehicles described in subsection (1)(b)

1 **of this section; or**

2 **“(b) Sixty-five miles per hour for all other vehicles.**

3 **“(11) A person commits the offense of violating a speed limit if the**
4 **person drives a vehicle on the portion of State Highway 26 beginning**
5 **in John Day and ending in Vale at a speed greater than:**

6 **“(a) Sixty miles per hour for vehicles described in subsection (1)(b)**
7 **of this section; or**

8 **“(b) Sixty-five miles per hour for all other vehicles.**

9 **“(12) The speed limits described in subsections (3) to (5) of this**
10 **section do not apply to portions of highways inside of a city in this**
11 **state.**

12 **“[(2)] (13) The offense described in this section, violating a speed limit,**
13 **is punishable as provided in ORS 811.109.”.**
