

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
HOUSE BILL 2282**

1 In line 2 of the printed bill, after “transportation” insert “; creating new  
2 provisions; and amending ORS 822.043”.

3 Delete lines 4 through 11 and insert:

4 **“SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2015 Act is added to and made a part  
5 of the Oregon Vehicle Code.**

6 **“SECTION 2. (1) As used in this section, ‘electronic signature’ has  
7 the meaning given that term in ORS 84.004.**

8 **“(2) The Department of Transportation may receive electronically  
9 transmitted documents necessary to:**

10 **“(a) Issue or transfer a certificate of title for a vehicle;**

11 **“(b) Register a vehicle or transfer registration of a vehicle;**

12 **“(c) Issue a registration plate; or**

13 **“(d) Comply with odometer disclosure requirements.**

14 **“(3) Except as required in ORS 803.094 and 803.205 for affidavits, an  
15 acknowledgement before a notary public is not required when a docu-  
16 ment or signature is transmitted electronically under this section.  
17 When an affidavit is required under ORS 803.094 or 803.205, the de-  
18 partment may accept a scanned copy of the person’s signature and a  
19 scanned copy of the notary public’s acknowledgment of the signature,  
20 which accurately reproduces the original signatures and contents of  
21 the document.**

22 **“(4) The department may adopt rules relating to the electronic**

1 **transmission of documents and the use of electronic signatures on**  
2 **documents described in subsection (2) of this section.**

3 **“SECTION 3.** ORS 822.043 is amended to read:

4 “822.043. (1) As used in this section:

5 “(a) ‘Integrator’ has the meaning given that term in ORS 802.600.

6 “(b) ‘Vehicle dealer’ means a person issued a vehicle dealer certificate  
7 under ORS 822.020.

8 “(2) A vehicle dealer may elect to prepare, submit, or prepare and submit  
9 documents necessary to:

10 “(a) Issue or transfer a certificate of title for a vehicle;

11 “(b) Register a vehicle or transfer registration of a vehicle; or

12 “(c) Issue a registration plate.

13 “(3) A vehicle dealer who prepares any documents described in subsection  
14 (2) of this section:

15 “(a) May charge a purchaser of a vehicle a fee for the preparation of  
16 those documents.

17 “(b) May not charge a purchaser of a vehicle a fee for the submission of  
18 any document or the issuance of a registration plate.

19 **“(c) May charge a purchaser of a vehicle a fee for performing any**  
20 **of the following services in connection with preparing the documents**  
21 **described in subsection (2) of this section:**

22 **“(A) Verifying and clearing titles;**

23 **“(B) Perfecting, releasing or satisfying liens or other security in-**  
24 **terests;**

25 **“(C) Complying with federal security requirements; and**

26 **“(D) Any other services rendered by a vehicle dealer for the purpose**  
27 **of complying with state and federal laws related to the sale of a vehi-**  
28 **cle.**

29 **“(4) The fee charged by a vehicle dealer under this section may not**  
30 **exceed:**

1       **“(a) \$150, if the vehicle dealer uses an integrator; or**  
2       **“(b) \$115, if the vehicle dealer does not use an integrator.**

3       *“[(4) The Department of Transportation may adopt rules to:]*

4       *“[(a) Limit the amount of a fee charged under subsection (3) of this section.*  
5       *The limit established by rule may not be less than:]*

6       *“[(A) \$75, if the vehicle dealer uses an integrator; or]*

7       *“[(B) \$50, if the vehicle dealer does not use an integrator.]*

8       *“[(b) Determine when a vehicle dealer is required to inform the purchaser*  
9       *of the vehicle of the option of using an integrator and when the purchaser has*  
10       *the option of electing to use an integrator.]*

11       **“(5) If a vehicle dealer charges a fee under subsection (4)(a) of this**  
12       **section, of the amount collected \$25 shall be paid to the integrator.**

13       *“[(5)] (6) Unless otherwise provided by rule, if a vehicle dealer uses an*  
14       *integrator and charges a fee greater than that charged for not using an*  
15       *integrator, the dealer must inform the purchaser of the vehicle of the option*  
16       *of using an integrator to prepare the documents. The purchaser may then*  
17       *elect whether or not to have the vehicle dealer use an integrator to prepare*  
18       *the documents.”.*
