PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 629

- On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after "homelessness" insert a period and delete the rest of the line and delete line 3.
- Delete lines 5 through 30 and delete pages 2 through 5 and insert:
- 4 "SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section:
- 5 "(a)(A) 'Persons experiencing homelessness' means persons who
- 6 lack, or are perceived to lack, a fixed, regular and adequate nighttime
- 7 residence or who have a primary nighttime residence in a shelter, on
- 8 the street, in a vehicle or in an enclosure or structure that is not au-
- 9 thorized or not fit for human habitation.

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- 10 "(B) 'Persons experiencing homelessness' includes:
- "(i) Persons who reside in a residential hotel or any other location without tenancy rights.
- 13 "(ii) Families with children staying in a residential hotel, whether 14 with or without tenancy rights.
- "(b)(A) 'Public space' means any property that is owned, in whole or in part, by state government or a local government, or upon which there is an easement for public use, and that is held open to the public.
- "(B) 'Public space' includes but is not limited to plazas, courtyards, parking lots, sidewalks, public transportation facilities and services, public buildings and parks.
 - "(C) 'Public space' does not mean a private business establishment.

"(2) A person experiencing homelessness has a privacy interest in, and a reasonable expectation of privacy in, all property belonging to the person regardless of whether the property is located in a public space."

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
