## PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO

 HOUSE BILL 3141On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 4 through 31 and delete page $\underline{2}$ and insert:
"SECTION 1. ORS 646A. 075 is amended to read:
"646A.075. (1) As used in this section:
"(a) 'Dog' means a member of the subspecies Canis lupus familiaris or a hybrid of that subspecies.
"(b) 'Litter' means one or more dogs, sold individually or together, that are all or part of a group of dogs born to the same mother at the same time.
"(c) 'Retail pet store' means:
"(A) A retail establishment open to the public that sells or offers to sell dogs[.];
"(B) A person that provides or offers to provide dogs on a lease or rental basis; or
"(C) A person that assumes ownership of dogs from persons who retain possession while paying a fee for dog supplies or services.
"(d) 'Retail pet store' does not mean a person that sells [or offers to sell], provides by lease or rental, assumes ownership of, offers to sell or offers to provide by lease or rental only dogs:
"(A) That were bred or raised by the person; [or]
"(B) That are kept primarily for the purpose of reproduction; or
"(C) That are provided by lease or rental for a period not exceeding 14 days under an agreement that does not provide for automatic ex-
tension or renewal of the lease or rental.
"(2) A retail pet store that offers a dog for sale, lease or rental shall, prior to accepting an offer to purchase, lease or rent the dog, provide the person making the offer with the following information, in writing, regarding the dog:
"(a) If known, the breed, age and date of birth for the dog.
"(b) The sex and color of the dog.
"(c) A list, and accompanying proof, of all inoculations that have been given to the dog by any person, and the date of those inoculations.
"(d) A list of all medical treatment provided to the dog by any person, the date or treatment and the reasons for the treatment.
"(e) If known, the name and business address of the breeder and of the facility where the dog was born.
"(f) If the information described in paragraph (e) of this subsection is unknown, the name and address for the earliest source of the dog known to the retail pet store.
" $[(f)]$ (g) If the breeder holds a license issued by the United States Department of Agriculture, the breeder's federal identification number.
" $[(g)]$ (h) The retail price [of], lease rate or rental rate for the dog.
" $[h)]$ (i) Any congenital disorder or hereditary diseases in the parents of the dog known to the pet dealer.
"( $\mathbf{j}$ ) If the dog is being provided by lease or rental, a statement that the person obtaining possession is not the owner of the dog.
"(k) If the dog is being provided by lease or rental, a statement that the retail pet store retains ultimate authority to determine the level and source of veterinary care for the dog.
"[(i)] ( $\mathbf{L}$ ) If the dog is being sold with the representation that the dog qualifies for registration with a pedigree organization:
"(A) The name and registration numbers of the parents of the dog; and
"(B) The name and address of the pedigree organization with which the
parents of the dog are registered.
"[ $(j)]$ ( $\mathbf{m}$ ) If the dog has previously been sold by the retail pet store and returned by the purchaser, the reason for the return.
" $[(k)]$ (n) A statement in substantially the following form, with the applicable provision number circled:
"
The facility in which this dog was born has produced:

1. 0 to 2 litters during the one-year period preceding the day this dog was born.
2. 3 to 10 litters during the one-year period preceding the day this dog was born.
3. 11 to 39 litters during the one-year period preceding the day this dog was born.
4. 40 or more litters during the one-year period preceding the day this dog was born.
"
"(3) A retail pet store that enters into an assumption of ownership described in subsection (1)(c)(C) of this section shall, prior to assuming ownership of the dog, provide the person who will be retaining possession of the dog with the following information, in writing, regarding the dog:
"(a) The total of one-time charges to be paid by the person and the periodic fee rate for dog supplies and services.
"(b) A statement that the person retaining possession is surrendering ownership of the dog.
"(c) A statement that the retail pet store is acquiring ultimate authority to determine the level and source of veterinary care for the dog.".
