8 **2015 Act, ‘enterprise information technology and telecommunications’**
9 **means:**

10 **“(a) Technologies, resources, systems and services that state agen-**
11 **cies use to generate, process, store and secure information for gov-**
12 **ernmental purposes, including geographic information;**

13 **“(b) Technologies, resources, systems and services that state agen-**
14 **cies use to send, receive, process or otherwise facilitate telecommuni-**
15 **cations for governmental purposes; and**

16 **“(c) Technologies, resources, systems and services that state agen-**
17 **cies use to install, maintain, repair, update, replace, remove or oth-**
18 **erwise support the technologies, resources, systems or services**
19 **described in paragraphs (a) and (b) of this subsection.**

20 **“(2)(a) Except as otherwise provided in this section, sections 2 to 8**
21 **of this 2015 Act and the amendments to ORS 84.064, 181.715, 181.725,**
22 **182.122, 182.124, 182.128, 182.132, 184.473, 184.475, 184.477, 184.483, 184.484,**

1 184.486, 279A.050, 279A.075, 279B.075, 283.120, 283.140, 283.143, 283.505,
2 283.510, 283.515, 283.520, 283.524, 291.016, 291.018, 291.032, 291.034, 291.038,
3 291.039, 291.042, 291.047, 291.990, 403.450, 403.455, 403.460 and 413.308 and
4 sections 1, 3, 4 and 5, chapter 782, Oregon Laws 2009, section 1, chapter
5 77, Oregon Laws 2014, and sections 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15 and 17,
6 chapter 87, Oregon Laws 2014, by sections 9 to 60 of this 2015 Act, the
7 duties, functions and powers that the Oregon Department of Admin-
8 istrative Services has with respect to enterprise information technol-
9 ogy and telecommunications are imposed upon, transferred to and
10 vested in the State Chief Information Officer.

11 “(b) The duties, functions and powers described in paragraph (a) of
12 this subsection include, but are not limited to:

13 “(A) The duty and function to plan and set standards for, coordi-
14 nate and oversee enterprise information technology and telecommu-
15 nications among state agencies; and

16 “(B) The power to specify policies, goals and directives and adopt
17 rules related to enterprise information technology and telecommuni-
18 cations among state agencies.

19 **“SECTION 2. (1) The Director of the Oregon Department of Ad-**
20 **ministrative Services shall manage and organize the Oregon Depart-**
21 **ment of Administrative Services to ensure that the department fulfills**
22 **the duties, implements the functions and exercises the powers that**
23 **remain to the department with respect to enterprise information**
24 **technology and telecommunications in a manner that is consistent**
25 **with the manner in which the State Chief Information Officer fulfills**
26 **the duties, implements the functions and exercises the powers that are**
27 **imposed upon, transferred to and vested in the State Chief Informa-**
28 **tion Officer under section 1 of this 2015 Act.**

29 “(2) The Governor shall resolve any dispute between the State Chief
30 Information Officer and the department that relates to the apportion-

1 ment of duties, functions and powers under section 1 of this 2015 Act
2 and as to the director's management and organization of the depart-
3 ment under this section. The Governor's decision under this sub-
4 section is final.

5 **SECTION 3.** (1) The State Chief Information Officer, in consulta-
6 tion with the Director of the Oregon Department of Administrative
7 Services, shall direct and oversee the expenditure of all moneys for
8 enterprise information technology and telecommunications that are
9 appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administrative Services and
10 that are necessary for the State Chief Information Officer to fulfill the
11 duties, implement the functions and exercise the powers imposed
12 upon, transferred to and vested in the State Chief Information Officer
13 under section 1 of this 2015 Act.

14 **"(2)** The expenditure classifications, if any, established by Acts that
15 authorize or limit expenditures by the department remain applicable
16 to expenditures that the State Chief Information Officer directs or
17 oversees under this section.

18 **SECTION 4.** The State Chief Information Officer's assumption of
19 duties, functions and powers in accordance with section 1 of this 2015
20 Act does not affect any action, proceeding or prosecution involving or
21 with respect to the duties, functions and powers that began before and
22 were pending at the time the State Chief Information Officer assumed
23 the duties, functions and powers.

24 **SECTION 5.** (1) Sections 1 to 8 of this 2015 Act and the amend-
25 ments to ORS 84.064, 181.715, 181.725, 182.122, 182.124, 182.128, 182.132,
26 184.473, 184.475, 184.477, 184.483, 184.484, 184.486, 279A.050, 279A.075,
27 279B.075, 283.120, 283.140, 283.143, 283.505, 283.510, 283.515, 283.520, 283.524,
28 291.016, 291.018, 291.032, 291.034, 291.038, 291.039, 291.042, 291.047, 291.990,
29 403.450, 403.455, 403.460 and 413.308 and sections 1, 3, 4 and 5, chapter
30 782, Oregon Laws 2009, section 1, chapter 77, Oregon Laws 2014, and

1 sections 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15 and 17, chapter 87, Oregon Laws 2014,
2 by sections 9 to 60 of this 2015 Act do not relieve a person of a liability,
3 duty or obligation accruing under or with respect to the duties, func-
4 tions and powers transferred by section 1 of this 2015 Act. The State
5 Chief Information Officer may collect or enforce any such liability,
6 duty or obligation.

7 “(2)(a) The rights and obligations that the Oregon Department of
8 Administrative Services legally incurred under contracts, leases and
9 business transactions the department executed, entered into or began
10 before the operative date of section 1 of this 2015 Act and that accrued
11 under or with respect to the duties, functions and powers transferred
12 by section 1 of this 2015 Act remain with the department unless the
13 Director of the Oregon Department of Administrative Services deleg-
14 ates or transfers the rights and obligations to the State Chief Infor-
15 mation Officer. For the purpose of succession to rights or obligations
16 that the director delegates or transfers to the State Chief Information
17 Officer, the State Chief Information Officer is a continuation of the
18 department and not a new authority.

19 “(b) The rights and obligations that the State Chief Information
20 Officer or the department legally incurs under contracts, leases or
21 business transactions related to enterprise information technology and
22 telecommunications after the operative date of section 1 of this 2015
23 Act belong to the State Chief Information Officer.

24 “SECTION 6. Notwithstanding the State Chief Information Officer’s
25 assumption of duties, functions and powers in accordance with section
26 1 of this 2015 Act, the rules of the Oregon Department of Administra-
27 tive Services, with respect to duties, functions or powers, that are in
28 effect on the operative date of section 1 of this 2015 Act continue in
29 effect until the State Chief Information Officer supersedes or repeals
30 the rules.

1 **“SECTION 7. If an uncodified law or resolution of the Legislative**
2 **Assembly, or a rule, document, record or proceeding that the Legisla-**
3 **tive Assembly authorizes, refers to the Oregon Department of Admin-**
4 **istrative Services in the context of a duty, function or power the State**
5 **Chief Information Officer assumes under section 1 of this 2015 Act, the**
6 **reference is a reference to the State Chief Information Officer or an**
7 **officer or employee of the office of the State Chief Information Officer**
8 **who by sections 1 to 7 of this 2015 Act is charged with carrying out the**
9 **duties, functions and powers.**

10 **“SECTION 8. (1) There is established the State Information Tech-**
11 **nology Operating Fund in the State Treasury, separate and distinct**
12 **from the General Fund. The moneys in the State Information Tech-**
13 **nology Operating Fund may be invested as provided in ORS 293.701 to**
14 **293.857. Interest earnings on the fund assets must be credited to the**
15 **fund.**

16 **“(2) The Director of the Oregon Department of Administrative Ser-**
17 **vices shall deposit into the State Information Technology Operating**
18 **Fund moneys for enterprise information technology and telecommu-**
19 **nications that are appropriated to the Oregon Department of Admin-**
20 **istrative Services and that are necessary for the State Chief**
21 **Information Officer to fulfill the duties, implement the functions and**
22 **exercise the powers imposed upon, transferred to and vested in the**
23 **State Chief Information Officer under section 1 of this 2015 Act.**
24 **Amounts in the fund are continuously appropriated to the State Chief**
25 **Information Officer for the purposes authorized by law.”.**

4 the State Chief Information Officer develops, sets or adopts. The information
5 technology initiative is subject to the State Chief Information Officer’s
6 oversight and the State Chief Information Officer may require the state
7 agency to obtain approval to implement the information technology initiative
8 or may direct the state agency to stop or modify the implementation, cancel
9 or modify a procurement related to the information technology initiative,
10 modify the scope of the information technology initiative or take another
11 action before awarding a public contract. After a state agency executes a
12 public contract related to the information technology initiative, the State
13 Chief Information Officer may direct the state agency to suspend the public
14 contract or terminate the public contract in accordance with the public
15 contract’s terms and conditions.”.

6 order goods, services or personal services.

7 “(b) The director may delegate to the State Chief Information Officer the
8 exclusive authority to procure or supervise the procurement of all price
9 agreements related to information technology and telecommunications on
10 behalf of the state agencies identified in subsection (6) of this section.
11 Notwithstanding any authority that a state agency may have under sub-
12 section (3) or (6) of this section, the state agency may not establish a price
13 agreement or enter into a contract for goods, services, personal services,
14 construction materials, equipment or supplies without the approval of the
15 director or the State Chief Information Officer if the director or the State
16 Chief Information Officer has established a price agreement for the goods,
17 services, personal services, construction materials, equipment or supplies.

18 “(c) The State Chief Information Officer may review any solicitation
19 document for procuring information technology or telecommunications that
20 a state contracting agency intends to issue before the state contracting
21 agency issues the solicitation document and may require the state contract-
22 ing agency to name the State Chief Information Officer as a third-party
23 beneficiary with full authority to enforce the terms and conditions of any
24 public contract for information technology or telecommunications. The State
25 Chief Information Officer must approve a state contracting agency’s pro-
26 curement for information technology or telecommunications if the procure-
27 ment has an anticipated contract price of \$1 million or more. The State Chief
28 Information Officer may require the state contracting agency to name the
29 State Chief Information Officer as the contracting party on behalf of the
30 State of Oregon in a procurement for information technology or telecommu-

1 nications that has an anticipated contract price of \$1 million or more.”.

27 department may charge the cost of maintaining and operating any central
28 telephone exchange, switching system, network service and facility, intercity
29 or intracity network trunk or line or switchboard to the state agencies that
30 the department serves and the department shall charge the cost of providing

1 mail, shuttle bus and messenger services to the state agencies that the de-
2 partment serves. The state agencies shall pay the costs to the department in
3 the same manner in which the state agencies pay other claims.”.

10 *for providing telecommunications services to state agencies, impose upon each*
11 *agency and public corporation a surcharge, in an amount established by the*
12 *department. All surcharge moneys collected shall be deposited in the Oregon*
13 *Department of Administrative Services Operating Fund, and may be expended*
14 *only for state agency and public corporation telecommunication and*
15 *videoconferencing activities, under such terms and conditions as the depart-*
16 *ment may prescribe.]*

17 *“[(2) Notwithstanding subsection (1) of this section, the Oregon Department*
18 *of Administrative Services shall not impose the surcharge established by this*
19 *section on the Oregon University System or the Oregon Health and Science*
20 *University. The Oregon Department of Administrative Services shall enter into*
21 *an agreement with the Oregon University System and the Oregon Health and*
22 *Science University on the amounts to be paid by the Oregon University System*
23 *and the Oregon Health and Science University to the Oregon Department of*
24 *Administrative Services in lieu of the surcharge provided for in this section.]*

25 **“(1) To encourage utilization of statewide integrated**
26 **videoconferencing and statewide online access services, the Oregon**
27 **Department of Administrative Services may, in addition to any other**
28 **charge or assessment for providing telecommunications services to**
29 **state agencies, impose upon each state agency and public corporation**
30 **a surcharge, in an amount the department establishes. The depart-**

1 **ment shall deposit all surcharge moneys into the Oregon Department**
2 **of Administrative Services Operating Fund. The department may ex-**
3 **pend moneys in the fund for state agency and public corporation**
4 **telecommunication and videoconferencing activities, under such terms**
5 **and conditions as the department may prescribe and in a manner that**
6 **is consistent with plans, standards, policies, goals, directives and rules**
7 **that the State Chief Information Officer sets, specifies or adopts.**

8 **“(2) Notwithstanding subsection (1) of this section, the Oregon De-**
9 **partment of Administrative Services may not impose the surcharge**
10 **established by this section on the Oregon University System or the**
11 **Oregon Health and Science University. The Oregon Department of**
12 **Administrative Services shall enter into an agreement with the Oregon**
13 **University System and the Oregon Health and Science University on**
14 **the amounts that the Oregon University System and the Oregon**
15 **Health and Science University must pay to the Oregon Department of**
16 **Administrative Services in lieu of the surcharge provided for in this**
17 **section.**

18 **“SECTION 28. ORS 283.505 is amended to read:**

19 ***“283.505. [(1) The Oregon Department of Administrative Services shall co-***
20 ***ordinate the consolidation and operation of all telecommunications systems***
21 ***used by the state and state agencies. Notwithstanding any other provision of***
22 ***law, no agent or agency of the state shall construct, purchase or otherwise gain***
23 ***access to a telecommunications system without the prior approval of the de-***
24 ***partment.]***

25 **“(1) The Oregon Department of Administrative Services shall coor-**
26 **dinate, in a manner that is consistent with plans, standards, policies,**
27 **goals, directives and rules that the State Chief Information Officer**
28 **sets, specifies or adopts, the consolidation and operation of all tele-**
29 **communications systems, including emergency telecommunications**
30 **systems, that the state and state agencies use. Notwithstanding any**

1 **other provision of law, an agent or agency of the state may not con-**
2 **struct, purchase or otherwise gain access to a telecommunications**
3 **system without the prior approval of the State Chief Information Of-**
4 **ficer.**

5 “(2) [*The department shall coordinate the consolidation and operation of*
6 *emergency telecommunications systems used by the state and state agencies.*
7 *The provisions of this section shall not be construed to require consolidation*
8 *of]* **The provisions of this section do not require emergency service**
9 **providers, as defined by the State Chief Information Officer, to con-**
10 **solidate** telecommunications systems [*used by*] **that** emergency service pro-
11 viders **use**[, *as defined by the department,*] into nonemergency networks.”.

27 directly, or shall enter into interagency or intergovernmental agreements
28 under ORS chapter 190 to have another state agency or another govern-
29 mental agency provide the telecommunications services and operations in a
30 manner that is consistent with the State Chief Information Officer’s rules,

1 polices and standards. The department may not approve the procurement of
2 any telecommunications system or equipment that is incompatible with the
3 network or that is inconsistent with the State Chief Information Officer’s
4 rules, polices and standards.”.
