- on which the person began practicing as a surgical technologist at the health
- 19 care facility.".
- Delete lines 38 through 45 and insert:
- "SECTION 6. (1) During the period beginning on July 1, 2016, and
- 22 ending on July 1, 2017, sections 1 and 2 of this 2015 Act do not apply

- "(2) As used in this section, 'rural or medically underserved community' means a geographic area of this state that is 10 or more miles from the geographic center of a population center of 40,000 or more

- "SECTION 7. (1) Sections 1, 2, 4, 5 and 6 of this 2015 Act become operative on July 1, 2016.
  - "(2) Section 3 of this 2015 Act becomes operative on July 1, 2017.
  - "(3) The Oregon Health Authority may take any action before the operative dates specified in subsections (1) and (2) of this section that is necessary to enable the authority to exercise, on and after the operative dates specified in subsections (1) and (2) of this section, all of the duties, functions and powers conferred on the authority by sections 1 to 6 of this 2015 Act.
  - "SECTION 8. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect on its passage."
