

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
HOUSE BILL 2293**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after “transportation” insert “;  
2 amending ORS 184.618”.

3 Delete lines 4 through 11 and insert:

4 **“SECTION 1.** ORS 184.618 is amended to read:

5 “184.618. (1) As its primary duty, the Oregon Transportation Commission  
6 shall develop and maintain a state transportation policy and a comprehen-  
7 sive, long-range plan for a safe, multimodal transportation system for the  
8 state which encompasses economic efficiency, orderly economic development  
9 and environmental quality.

10 **“(2) The plan [shall] must include, but not be limited to, recommen-**  
11 **dations regarding:**

12 **“(a) Aviation, highways, mass transit, pipelines, ports, rails and**  
13 **waterways[.];**

14 **“(b) Strategies to effectively utilize multiple modes of transporta-**  
15 **tion to move persons in Oregon, including but not limited to the fol-**  
16 **lowing modes:**

17 **“(A) Air;**

18 **“(B) Marine;**

19 **“(C) Rail;**

20 **“(D) Public transit; and**

21 **“(E) Bicycle and pedestrian; and**

22 **“(c) Strategies to address deficiencies in the transportation system**

1 **that hinder the movement of people in Oregon.**

2 “~~(3)~~ [*The plan shall be used by*] All agencies and officers **shall use the**  
3 **plan** to guide and coordinate transportation activities and to [*insure*] **ensure**  
4 transportation planning utilizes the potential of all existing and developing  
5 modes of transportation.

6 “[~~2~~] **(4)** As the plan is developed by the commission, the Director of  
7 Transportation shall prepare, and submit to the commission for approval,  
8 implementation programs. Work approved by the commission to carry out the  
9 plan shall be assigned to the appropriate unit of the Department of Trans-  
10 portation.

11 “[~~3~~] **(5)** The director and members of the commission shall give safety,  
12 economic development and the provisions of industrial site services priority  
13 in fund allocation decisions.

14 “**(6) The commission shall review and update the plan at least once**  
15 **every six years.”**
