## PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO **HOUSE BILL 3248**

On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 5 through 20 and delete page 1 2. 2

On page 3, delete lines 1 through 30 and insert: 3

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"SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2015 Act is added to and made a part 4 of ORS 279.835 to 279.855. 5

"SECTION 2. If a public agency terminates a contract for services 6 with a qualified nonprofit agency for individuals with disabilities, or 7 if the contract for services expires, and the public agency enters into a new contract for services with a second qualified nonprofit agency for individuals with disabilities, the public agency shall provide in the 10 new contract that the second qualified nonprofit agency for individuals 11 with disabilities must, during a period that ends 90 days after the date 12 on which the public agency enters into the new contract, offer em-13 ployment to the individuals with disabilities who performed work un-14 der the expired or terminated contract on terms that are as favorable 15 to the individuals with disabilities as, or more favorable to the indi-16 viduals with disabilities than, the terms of employment that the indi-17 viduals with disabilities had under the expired or terminated contract. 18 The second qualified nonprofit agency for individuals with disabilities 19 may require an individual with a disability whom the second qualified 20 nonprofit agency for individuals hires under the circumstances described in this section to undergo the hiring procedures and demon-22

- strate during a probationary period the qualifications that the second
- 2 qualified nonprofit agency for individuals with disabilities establishes
- 3 for new hires.".

- 9 "(A) All of the qualified nonprofit agencies for individuals with disabili-
- ties on the procurement list that applies to the public agency have a record
- in the previous three years of repeatedly violating, or are not now in com-
- 12 pliance with, applicable local ordinances or resolutions that govern labor
- 13 standards; and
- 14 "(B) The person, for a period of 90 days after the person enters into an
- agreement with the public agency, offers to employ the employees of a qual-
- ified nonprofit agency for individuals with disabilities from which the public
- 17 agency would have procured the product or service but for the failure of the
- 18 qualified nonprofit agency for individuals with disabilities to comply with
- 19 an applicable local ordinance or resolution that governs labor standards.
- 20 "(c) If a public agency may choose to procure a product or service from
- 21 more than one qualified nonprofit agency for individuals with disabilities,
- 22 the public agency may give a preference to the qualified nonprofit agency for
- 23 individuals with disabilities that best demonstrates that the qualified
- 24 nonprofit agency for individuals with disabilities:
- 25 "(A) Complies with all applicable local ordinances and resolutions that
- 26 govern labor standards; and
- 27 "(B) Provides wages, health care benefits, alternative dispute resolution
- 28 services and pension or other retirement arrangements that, in the aggregate,
- are better than the average package of wages, health care benefits, alterna-
- 30 tive dispute resolution services and pension or other retirement arrange-

- ments that private employers provide to employees that perform the same or similar job duties:
- "(i) In the same industry in which the qualified nonprofit agency for individuals with disabilities engages; and
- 5 "(ii) In the county in which the qualified nonprofit agency for individuals 6 with disabilities will deliver the product or perform the service.
- "(2)(a) A public agency may require in any agreement with a qualified nonprofit agency for individuals with disabilities under ORS 279.835 to 279.855 that the qualified nonprofit agency for individuals with disabilities comply with applicable local ordinances or resolutions that govern labor standards.
- "(b) A public agency may disqualify a qualified nonprofit agency for individuals with disabilities from entering into an agreement with the public agency under ORS 279.835 to 279.855 for a period of three years if the public agency:
  - "(A) Determines that the qualified nonprofit agency for individuals with disabilities repeatedly violated local ordinances or resolutions that govern labor standards during the term of an agreement with the public agency under ORS 279.835 to 279.855; or
  - "(B) Finds that the qualified nonprofit agency for individuals with disabilities has a record in the previous three years of repeatedly violating applicable local ordinances or resolutions that govern labor standards.".
- On page 4, delete lines 1 through 14.

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- In line 15, delete "(2)" and insert "(3)".
- Delete lines 24 through 39 and insert:
- "SECTION 4. Section 2 of this 2015 Act and the amendments to ORS
  27 279.850 by section 3 of this 2015 Act apply to contracts into which a
  28 public agency enters on or after the operative date specified in section
  29 5 of this 2015 Act.
  - "SECTION 5. (1) Section 2 of this 2015 Act and the amendments to

ORS 279.850 by section 3 of this 2015 Act become operative January 1, 2016.

"(2) The Director of the Oregon Department of Administrative Services may adopt rules and take any other action before the operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section that is necessary to enable the director, on and after the operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section, to exercise all of the duties, functions and powers conferred on the director by section 2 of this 2015 Act and the amendments to ORS 279.850 by section 3 of this 2015 Act.

"SECTION 6. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect on its passage."

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
