

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
HOUSE BILL 2195**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 12 through 14 and insert:

2 “(C) Third, to refund the county general fund for all the costs and ex-  
3 penses incurred by the county in the maintenance and supervision of the  
4 properties and in any suits or proceedings by the county to quiet title to or  
5 to defend the county’s title to property sold, including but not limited to  
6 suits or land use proceedings to ascertain and determine the actual bounda-  
7 ries of the properties.”.

8 After line 23, insert:

9 “(c) In a county with a population of 650,000 or more, after the refunds  
10 authorized under paragraph (a) of this subsection are made, the county  
11 treasurer may credit the balance of the proceeds arising under ORS 275.090  
12 to 275.290 from the sale of real property acquired by the county through  
13 foreclosure of delinquent tax liens or by exchange for land originally ac-  
14 quired by foreclosure of delinquent tax liens, as provided in paragraph (d)  
15 of this subsection.”.

16 In line 24, delete “(c)” and insert “(d)”.

17 Delete line 30 and insert:

18 “(i) Funds for housing placement and retention support services for youth  
19 and families with children;

20 “(ii) Flexible rental assistance to place youth and families with children  
21 into housing; or

22 “(iii) Funds to develop new low income housing that is affordable to

1 youth and families with children with 30 percent or lower median family  
2 income.”.

3 On page 2, delete lines 1 and 2.

4 On page 3, after line 6, insert:

5 “(7) Notwithstanding subsection (1) of this section, a county with a pop-  
6 ulation of 650,000 or more may convey real property acquired by foreclosure  
7 of delinquent tax liens or by exchange for land originally acquired by fore-  
8 closure of delinquent tax liens as provided in ORS 271.330 or 311.796.”.

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
