- On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 25 through 30.
- On page 2, delete line 1 and insert:
- 3 "(3)(a) The Oregon Youth Authority and juvenile departments may dis-
- 4 close and provide copies of reports and other materials relating to the child,
- 5 ward, youth or youth offender's history and prognosis to the Department of
- 6 Corrections for the purpose of enabling the department to perform the
- 7 department's official duties relating to the exercise of custody or supervision
- 8 of a person committed to the legal and physical custody of the department.
- 9 "(b)(A) Except as provided in subparagraph (B) of this paragraph, the
- 10 Department of Corrections shall limit the use of reports and other materials
- 11 disclosed and provided to the department under this subsection to reports
- 12 and other materials that relate to a youth or youth offender's history and
- 13 prognosis as these pertain to:
- "(i) A person committed to the legal and physical custody of the depart-
- ment before the person became 29 years of age; and
- "(ii) Conduct or behaviors that the person engaged in after the person
- 17 became 12 years of age.
- 18 "(B) The Department of Corrections may use reports and other materials
- 19 relating to a youth or youth offender's history of previous referrals, arrests
- 20 or adjudications, regardless of the date of the person's commitment to the
- 21 legal and physical custody of the department or of the date on which the
- 22 person engaged in the conduct or behaviors:

- "(i) For the crimes of arson, escape, unauthorized departure, animal 1 abuse, aggravated animal abuse and sex crimes as defined in ORS 181.805; 2 \mathbf{or} 3
- "(ii) For the attempt to commit the crimes of arson, escape, unauthorized 4 departure, animal abuse, aggravated animal abuse and sex crimes as defined 5 in ORS 181.805. 6
- "(c) The Oregon Youth Authority, in consultation with juvenile depart-7 ments and the Department of Corrections, may adopt rules to carry out the 8 purposes of this subsection.".
