

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
A-ENGROSSED SENATE BILL 941**

1 On page 1 of the printed A-engrossed bill, line 2, after “firearms” delete
2 the rest of the line and delete lines 3 and 4 and insert a period.

3 Delete lines 6 through 20 and delete pages 2 through 23 and insert:

4 **“SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2015 Act is added to and made a part**
5 **of ORS 181.010 to 181.560.**

6 **“SECTION 2. (1) There is established within the Department of**
7 **State Police the Firearms Investigation Division. The division shall:**

8 **“(a) Assign no fewer than eight full-time equivalent officers or**
9 **troopers of the Oregon State Police to investigate unlawful transfers**
10 **of firearms to persons prohibited from possessing firearms under state**
11 **or federal law; and**

12 **“(b) Assign no fewer than two full-time equivalent employees to**
13 **engage in public education and outreach concerning firearm safety.**

14 **“(2) The public education and outreach described in subsection (1)**
15 **of this section:**

16 **“(a) Shall include the distribution of firearm safety kits, including**
17 **firearm locking devices, and educational support for the distribution**
18 **of firearm safety kits.**

19 **“(b) May include other public education and awareness efforts de-**
20 **signed to promote firearm safety and deter unlawful transfers of**
21 **firearms to persons prohibited from possessing firearms under state**
22 **or federal law.**

1 **“(3)(a) The Superintendent of State Police may enter into agree-**
2 **ments with federal, state, county and municipal law enforcement**
3 **agencies in order to effectuate the duties of the Firearms Investigation**
4 **Division or otherwise implement the provisions of this section.**

5 **“(b) The superintendent may form joint task forces or other multi-**
6 **agency groups including the Firearms Investigation Division and fed-**
7 **eral, state, county and municipal law enforcement agencies in order**
8 **to investigate and prosecute unlawful transfers of firearms to persons**
9 **prohibited from possessing firearms under state or federal law.**

10 **“(4) The Department of State Police may adopt rules to carry out**
11 **the provisions of this section.”.**
