5 "SECTION 1. ORS 166.416 is amended to read:

6 "166.416. (1) As used in this section:

7 "(a) 'Ammunition' means a cartridge, shell or projectile designed
8 to be expelled from a firearm.

9 "(b) 'Licensed dealer' means a person who is licensed pursuant to
10 18 U.S.C. 923 to engage in the business of dealing in firearms.

"(c) 'Materially false information' means information that repres ents or portrays that an unlawful firearm transaction is lawful.

"(d) 'Private seller' means a person who sells or offers for sale a
 firearm as defined in ORS 166.210 or ammunition.

"(2) A person commits the crime of providing false information in con nection with a transfer of a firearm if the person knowingly:

"(a) Provides to a licensed dealer or private seller a false name or
materially false information or presents false identification in connection
with a purchase or transfer of a firearm or ammunition, with the intent
to deceive the dealer or seller about the lawfulness of the purchase or
transfer[.]; or

²² "(b) Solicits, persuades, encourages or entices a licensed dealer or

private seller of firearms or ammunition to sell a firearm or ammunition under circumstances that the person knows would violate state
or federal law.

"[(2)] (3) Providing false information in connection with a transfer of a
firearm is a Class [A misdemeanor] C felony.

"(4) This section does not apply to a law enforcement officer acting
in the performance of official duties or to a person acting at the direction of the officer.".
