

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
SENATE BILL 175**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after “ORS” insert “496.705 and”.

2 On page 2, after line 33, insert:

3 **“SECTION 3.** ORS 496.705 is amended to read:

4 “496.705. (1) The State Fish and Wildlife Commission may institute suit  
5 for the recovery of damages for the unlawful taking or killing of any of the  
6 wildlife referred to in subsection (2) of this section that are the property of  
7 the state.

8 “(2)(a) The damages referred to in subsection (1) of this section are as  
9 follows:

10 “(A) Each game mammal other than moose, mountain sheep, mountain  
11 goat, elk, **black bear** or silver gray squirrel, or deer or antelope described  
12 in subparagraphs [(D) and (E)] **(E) and (F)** of this paragraph, \$1,000.

13 “(B) Each moose, mountain sheep or mountain goat, other than those de-  
14 scribed in subparagraphs [(F), (G) and (H)] **(G), (H) and (I)** of this para-  
15 graph, \$10,000.

16 “(C) Each elk, other than those described in subparagraph [(I)] **(J)** of this  
17 paragraph, \$1,500.

18 **“(D) Each black bear, \$5,000.**

19 “[D] **(E)** Each deer with at least four points on one antler, \$7,500.

20 “[E] **(F)** Each antelope with at least one horn equal to or greater than  
21 14 inches, \$7,500.

22 “[F] **(G)** Each moose with antlers, \$25,000.

1       “~~[(G)]~~ **(H)** Each mountain sheep that has at least one horn equal to or  
2 greater than one half curl, \$25,000.

3       “~~[(H)]~~ **(I)** Each mountain goat that has at least one horn equal to or  
4 greater than six inches, \$25,000.

5       “~~[(I)]~~ **(J)** Each elk with at least six points on one antler, \$15,000.

6       “~~[(J)]~~ **(K)** Each silver gray squirrel, \$20.

7       “~~[(K)]~~ **(L)** Each game bird other than wild turkey, \$20.

8       “~~[(L)]~~ **(M)** Each wild turkey, \$100.

9       “~~[(M)]~~ **(N)** Each game fish other than salmon, steelhead trout, halibut or  
10 sturgeon, \$10.

11       “~~[(N)]~~ **(O)** Each sturgeon other than those specified in subparagraph  
12 ~~[(O)]~~ **(P)** of this paragraph, salmon, steelhead trout or halibut, \$250.

13       “~~[(O)]~~ **(P)** Each oversized sturgeon, as specified by the commission by  
14 rule, \$1,000.

15       “~~[(P)]~~ **(Q)** Each fur-bearing mammal other than bobcat or fisher, \$100.

16       “~~[(Q)]~~ **(R)** Each bobcat or fisher, \$700.

17       “~~[(R)]~~ **(S)** Each specimen of any wildlife species whose survival is speci-  
18 fied by the wildlife laws or the laws of the United States as threatened or  
19 endangered, \$1,000.

20       “~~[(S)]~~ **(T)** Each specimen of any wildlife species otherwise protected by  
21 the wildlife laws or the laws of the United States, but not otherwise referred  
22 to in this subsection, \$50.

23       “~~[(T)]~~ **(U)** Each bald eagle, golden eagle, goshawk, osprey, peregrine  
24 falcon or any other raptor listed as a threatened species or an endangered  
25 species by the commission by rule, \$5,000.

26       “~~[(U)]~~ **(V)** Each raptor except those specified in subparagraph ~~[(T)]~~ **(U)**  
27 of this paragraph, \$2,000.

28       “(b) For purposes of this subsection:

29       “(A) A point must be at least one inch, measured from the main beam of  
30 the antler to the tip of the point.
