"SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, 2 the amount of \$250,000 is established for the biennium beginning July 3 1, 2015, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery 4 moneys allocated from the Administrative Services Economic Devel-5 opment Fund to the Oregon Business Development Department, for 6 business, innovation and trade, for the purpose of funding of cooper-7 ative efforts by the National Policy Consensus Center of Portland 8 State University and community organizations to: 9

- "(1) Provide businesses engaged in western juniper harvesting, or in the manufacturing of products from western juniper, with technical business assistance, market development and supply chain coordination between businesses, other private organizations and governmental entities; and
- "(2) Promote liaison efforts between public and private activities and programs within this state for western juniper harvesting and related manufacturing, and public and private activities and programs for wildlife management in order to address ecological or economic interests and concerns.
- "SECTION 2. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect July 1, 2015."
