

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
A-ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL 2408**

5 **“SECTION 102. (1) The unexpended balances authorized to be ex-**
6 **pended by the Department of Community Colleges and Workforce De-**
7 **velopment for a one-year period beginning July 1, 2015, from revenues**
8 **dedicated, continuously appropriated, appropriated or otherwise made**
9 **available for the purpose of administering and enforcing the duties,**
10 **functions and powers transferred from the Department of Community**
11 **Colleges and Workforce Development to the Higher Education Coordi-**
12 **nating Commission by the amendments to statutes by sections 1 to 99**
13 **of this 2015 Act by acquiring, constructing, improving, repairing,**
14 **equipping and furnishing buildings, structures, land and other projects**
15 **at community colleges pursuant to section 7 (1) and (7), chapter 904,**
16 **Oregon Laws 2009, and section 4 (3), chapter _____, Oregon Laws 2015**
17 **(Enrolled House Bill 5006), are transferred to and are available for ex-**
18 **penditure by the Higher Education Coordinating Commission for the**
19 **one-year period specified for the purpose of administering and enforc-**
20 **ing the duties, functions and powers transferred by the amendments**
21 **to statutes by sections 1 to 99 of this 2015 Act.**

22 **“(2) The unexpended balances authorized to be expended by the**

1 Department of Community Colleges and Workforce Development for
2 a two-year period beginning July 1, 2015, from revenues dedicated,
3 continuously appropriated, appropriated or otherwise made available
4 for the purpose of administering and enforcing the duties, functions
5 and powers transferred from the Department of Community Colleges
6 and Workforce Development to the Higher Education Coordinating
7 Commission by the amendments to statutes by sections 1 to 99 of this
8 2015 Act for community college districts for capital construction, de-
9 ferred maintenance capital renewal, code compliance and safety
10 projects pursuant to section 2, chapter 78, Oregon Laws 2012, and sec-
11 tion 11 (1), (3), (4) to (6), (8), (10), (11), (13), (14) and (17), chapter 79,
12 Oregon Laws 2012, are transferred to and are available for expenditure
13 by the Higher Education Coordinating Commission for the two-year
14 period specified for the purpose of administering and enforcing the
15 duties, functions and powers transferred by the amendments to stat-
16 utes by sections 1 to 99 of this 2015 Act.

17 “(3) The unexpended balances authorized to be expended by the
18 Department of Community Colleges and Workforce Development for
19 a period ending July 1, 2015, from revenues dedicated, continuously
20 appropriated, appropriated or otherwise made available for the purpose
21 of administering and enforcing the duties, functions and powers
22 transferred from the Department of Community Colleges and
23 Workforce Development to the Higher Education Coordinating Com-
24 mission by the amendments to statutes by sections 1 to 99 of this 2015
25 Act by acquiring, constructing, improving, repairing, equipping and
26 furnishing buildings, structures, land and other projects at community
27 colleges pursuant to section 7 (9), chapter 904, Oregon Laws 2009, are
28 transferred to and are available for expenditure by the Higher Educa-
29 tion Coordinating Commission for the six-year period specified for the
30 purpose of administering and enforcing the duties, functions and

1 powers transferred by the amendments to statutes by sections 1 to 99
2 of this 2015 Act.

3 “(4) The unexpended balances authorized to be expended by the
4 Department of Community Colleges and Workforce Development for
5 a four-year period beginning July 1, 2015, from revenues dedicated,
6 continuously appropriated, appropriated or otherwise made available
7 for the purpose of administering and enforcing the duties, functions
8 and powers transferred from the Department of Community Colleges
9 and Workforce Development to the Higher Education Coordinating
10 Commission by the amendments to statutes by sections 1 to 99 of this
11 2015 Act by acquiring, constructing, improving, repairing, equipping
12 and furnishing buildings, structures, land and other projects at com-
13 munity colleges pursuant to section 6 (2) to (5), (8), (9), (11) and (14),
14 chapter 727, Oregon Laws 2013, and sections 3 (1) and 4, chapter 120,
15 Oregon Laws 2014, are transferred to and are available for expenditure
16 by the Higher Education Coordinating Commission for the four-year
17 period specified for the purpose of administering and enforcing the
18 duties, functions and powers transferred by the amendments to stat-
19 utes by sections 1 to 99 of this 2015 Act.”.
