

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 3300**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 4 through 30 and delete page
2 2 and insert:

3 **“SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section:**

4 **“(a) ‘Benefit plan,’ ‘eligible employee’ and ‘family member’ have the**
5 **meaning given those terms in ORS 243.105; and**

6 **“(b) ‘Primary care physician’ has the meaning given that term in**
7 **ORS 442.470.**

8 **“(2) The Public Employees’ Benefit Board may not, directly or**
9 **through a third party administrator, enter into or renew a contract**
10 **with a primary care physician for the payment or reimbursement of**
11 **claims for health care provided to eligible employees or family mem-**
12 **bers residing in Lane County, Oregon, unless the physician accepts**
13 **patients who are recipients of medical assistance. A physician is con-**
14 **sidered to accept patients who are recipients of medical assistance if:**

15 **“(a) At least 15 percent of the physician’s total number of patients**
16 **are medical assistance recipients; or**

17 **“(b) The physician is willing to accept as patients a number of**
18 **medical assistance recipients sufficient to constitute 15 percent of the**
19 **physician’s total number of patients, but is unable, despite due dili-**
20 **gence, to attract enough medical assistance recipients as patients to**
21 **meet the requirement.**

22 **“(3) Prior to entering into or renewing a contract with a primary**

1 care physician to provide health care to eligible employees or family
2 members residing in Lane County, Oregon, who are enrolled in a
3 benefit plan offered by the board, the board or a third party adminis-
4 trator shall require the physician to report, in the manner prescribed
5 by the board, information necessary for the board to determine
6 whether the physician meets the requirements of subsection (2) of this
7 section.

8 **“SECTION 2. (1) As used in this section:**

9 **“(a) ‘Benefit plan,’ ‘eligible employee’ and ‘family member’ have the**
10 **meaning given those terms in ORS 243.860; and**

11 **“(b) ‘Primary care physician’ has the meaning given that term in**
12 **ORS 442.470.**

13 **“(2) The Oregon Educators Benefit Board may not, directly or**
14 **through a third party administrator, enter into or renew a contract**
15 **with a primary care physician for the payment or reimbursement of**
16 **claims for health care provided to eligible employees or family mem-**
17 **bers residing in Lane County, Oregon, unless the physician accepts**
18 **patients who are recipients of medical assistance. A physician is con-**
19 **sidered to accept patients who are recipients of medical assistance if:**

20 **“(a) At least 15 percent of the physician’s total number of patients**
21 **are medical assistance recipients; or**

22 **“(b) The physician is willing to accept as patients a number of**
23 **medical assistance recipients sufficient to constitute 15 percent of the**
24 **physician’s total number of patients, but is unable, despite due dili-**

27 **“(3) Prior to entering into or renewing a contract with a primary**

1 trator shall require the physician to report, in the manner prescribed
2 by the board, information necessary for the board to determine
3 whether the physician meets the requirements of subsection (2) of this
4 section.

5 **“SECTION 3. (1) Not later than February 1, 2019, the Public**
6 **Employees’ Benefit Board shall submit a report to the Legislative As-**
7 **sembly, in the manner provided in ORS 192.245, on the extent to which**
8 **section 1 of this 2015 Act has increased medical recipients’ access to**
9 **timely primary care in Lane County, Oregon.**

10 **“(2) Not later than February 1, 2019, the Oregon Educators Benefit**
11 **Board shall submit a report to the Legislative Assembly, in the man-**
12 **ner provided in ORS 192.245, on the extent to which section 2 of this**
13 **2015 Act has increased medical recipients’ access to timely primary**
14 **care in Lane County, Oregon.**

15 **“SECTION 4. Sections 1 and 2 of this 2015 Act are repealed on Jan-**
16 **uary 2, 2020.**

17 **“SECTION 5. Sections 1 and 2 of this 2015 Act apply to contracts**
18 **entered into or renewed on or after the effective date of the 2015**
19 **Act.”.**

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
