

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 2995**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 3, delete the first “and” and before the
2 period insert “; and declaring an emergency”.

3 On page 5, after line 9, insert:

4 **“SECTION 5. (1) The Governor shall convene a work group to advise**
5 **on the development and implementation of a statewide insurance**
6 **standard applying to all commercial vehicles that provide transporta-**
7 **tion services.**

8 **“(2) The work group shall:**

9 **“(a) Review state, county and municipal laws governing insurance**
10 **requirements for commercial for-hire vehicles and taxicab services;**

11 **“(b) Evaluate whether current insurance requirements adequately**
12 **protect the public from harm; and**

13 **“(c) Identify adjustments in insurance requirements necessary for**
14 **statewide implementation.**

15 **“(3) The work group shall issue findings and make recommen-**
16 **dations for legislation in a report submitted to the Department of**
17 **Transportation, the Department of Consumer and Business Services**
18 **and interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to trans-**
19 **portation no later than January 13, 2016.**

20 **“(4) Members of the work group who are not members of the Leg-**
21 **islative Assembly are not entitled to compensation, but may be reim-**
22 **bursed for actual and necessary travel and other expenses incurred by**

1 **them in the performance of their official duties in the manner and**
2 **amounts provided for in ORS 292.495. Claims for expenses incurred in**
3 **performing functions of the work group shall be paid out of funds ap-**
4 **propriated to the Department of Consumer and Business Services for**
5 **purposes of the work group.”.**

6 In line 10, delete “5” and insert “6”.

7 After line 12, insert:

8 **“SECTION 7. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate**
9 **preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is**
10 **declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect on its passage.”.**
