  - "(3) The department may undertake any actions reasonable or necessary to carry out its duties under this section. All agencies of state government, as defined in ORS 174.111, are directed to assist the de-

- partment in the performance of its duties under this section and, to the extent permitted by laws relating to confidentiality, to furnish such information and advice as the department considers necessary to perform its duties under this section.
- "(4) The department shall complete its work under this section and 5 report the results to an interim committee of the Legislative Assembly 6 relating to natural resources no later than September 1, 2016. The re-7 port shall include, but need not be limited to, recommendations of the 8 department regarding the need for, and size of, buffer zones to protect 9 schools, homes, fish-bearing streams and drinking water sources that 10 are in proximity to forestland from impacts due to the application of 11 pesticides by aircraft.". 12
