

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
SENATE BILL 958**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 4 through 9 and insert:

2 **“SECTION 1. (1) An organizer of a fishing derby may apply for and**  
3 **obtain from the State Fish and Wildlife Commission a fishing derby**  
4 **license to take northern pikeminnow and to sell, for charitable fund-**  
5 **raising purposes, northern pikeminnow taken during the duration of**  
6 **the derby. A fee may not be charged for the license.**

7 **“(2) Upon receipt of an application for a fishing derby license, the**  
8 **commission shall review the application and issue a fishing derby li-**  
9 **cence if the commission determines that the fishing derby will comply**  
10 **with the rules of the commission related to the protection of native**  
11 **fish species, including northern pikeminnow, and will be conducted in**  
12 **a manner that minimizes impacts on sensitive populations or habitats,**  
13 **except that the commission may issue no more than two fishing derby**  
14 **licenses per year for a given body of water.**

15 **“(3) A fishing derby for which a fishing derby license has been ob-**  
16 **tained under this section may have a duration of no longer than three**  
17 **days.**

18 **“(4) An organizer of a fishing derby is required to obtain a separate**  
19 **fishing derby license for each fishing derby.**

20 **“(5) The commission may adopt rules necessary to implement the**  
21 **provisions of this section. Notwithstanding ORS 508.025, 508.030,**  
22 **508.035, 508.235, 508.260, 508.505 and 508.535, rules adopted by the com-**

1 **mission may provide that separate licenses under the commercial**  
2 **fishing laws are not required for an organizer or a person to partic-**  
3 **ipate in a fishing derby for which the organizer holds a fishing derby**  
4 **license issued under this section.**

5 **“(6) This section is not intended to and may not be interpreted to**  
6 **exempt an organizer or a person participating in a fishing derby from**  
7 **any applicable licensing requirements under the wildlife laws.”.**
