

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
A-ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL 2357
(INCLUDING AMENDMENTS TO RESOLVE CONFLICTS)**

1 On page 1 of the printed A-engrossed bill, line 16, after “officer” insert
2 “, unless the person who is a retired law enforcement officer has been con-
3 victed of an offense that would make the person ineligible to obtain a con-
4 cealed handgun license under ORS 166.291 and 166.292”.

5 On page 2, line 30, after “(4)” insert “(a)”.

6 After line 31, insert:

7 “(b) A person may not use the affirmative defense described in subsection
8 (1)(c) of this section if the person has been convicted of an offense that
9 would make the person ineligible to obtain a concealed handgun license un-
10 der ORS 166.291 and 166.292.”.

11 In line 35, delete the period and insert a semicolon.

12 In line 36, delete the period and insert “; or”.

13 In line 37, after “officer” insert “, unless the person has been convicted
14 of an offense that would make the person ineligible to obtain a concealed
15 handgun license under ORS 166.291 and 166.292”.

16 On page 3, line 30, after “(4)” insert “(a)”.

17 After line 31, insert:

18 “(b) A person may not use the affirmative defense described in subsection
19 (3)(e) of this section if the person has been convicted of an offense that
20 would make the person ineligible to obtain a concealed handgun license un-
21 der ORS 166.291 and 166.292.”.

1 On page 4, line 20, after “officer” insert “, unless the person has been
2 convicted of an offense that would make the person ineligible to obtain a
3 concealed handgun license under ORS 166.291 and 166.292”.

4 In line 33, delete the period and insert a semicolon.

5 In line 34, delete the period and insert “; or”.

6 In line 35, after “officer” insert “, unless the person who is a retired law
7 enforcement officer has been convicted of an offense that would make the
8 person ineligible to obtain a concealed handgun license under ORS 166.291
9 and 166.292”.
