- "(3) A local government or other governmental subdivision of this state 6 may not enact a rule, regulation, ordinance or resolution concerning synthetic plastic microbeads in personal care products or over-the-counter drugs that differs from the requirements of this section.
 - "(4) Violation of the provisions of this section is an unlawful trade practice under ORS 646.608 that is subject to enforcement under ORS 646.632 or an action under ORS 646.638.".

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
