

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 3085**

1 In line 2 of the printed bill, before the period insert “; and providing that
2 this Act shall be referred to the people of the City of Damascus for their
3 approval or rejection”.

4 Delete lines 4 through 26 and insert:

5 **“SECTION 1. (1) Notwithstanding ORS 221.650, during the period
6 that begins on the 30th day following the date of the election held
7 pursuant to section 2 of this 2015 Act and ends on the 60th day fol-
8 lowing the date of the election, the City of Damascus shall:**

9 **“(a) Expend moneys in the funds of the city to satisfy all debts,
10 obligations, liabilities and expenses of the city, and transfer moneys
11 to Clackamas County, in the manner required under section 1 (2),
12 chapter _____, Oregon Laws 2015 (Enrolled House Bill 3086); and**

13 **“(b) Convey, grant, assign and deliver all of the city’s real property
14 and tangible and intangible personal property, other than moneys ex-
15 pended or transferred under paragraph (a) of this subsection, by proper
16 conveyance, to Clackamas County for the benefit and use of the
17 county.**

18 **“(2) Notwithstanding ORS 221.610 and 221.621, on the 61st day fol-
19 lowing the date of the election held pursuant to section 2 of this 2015
20 Act:**

21 **“(a) The City of Damascus shall surrender its charter,
22 disincorporate and cease to exist.**

1 **“(b)(A) The city shall cease to exist in its corporate capacity with-**
2 **out any further or other formal action;**

3 **“(B) The city’s property rights and interests shall vest in Clackamas**
4 **County; and**

5 **“(C) The auditor, clerk or other keeper of records in the city shall**
6 **deposit the records of the city in the office of the county clerk.**

7 **“SECTION 2. This 2015 Act shall be submitted to the people of the**
8 **City of Damascus for their approval or rejection, by a majority of the**
9 **voters voting on this 2015 Act, at a special election held on the same**
10 **date as the next primary election.”.**
