

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 3400**

1 On page 6 of the typed amendments to House Bill 3400 dated June 8 (HB
2 3400-9), delete lines 19 through 21 and insert “residence.”.

3 On page 18, line 15, after “Must” insert “, until January 1, 2020,”.

4 In line 17, delete “and” and insert “, and must provide proof that the ap-
5 plicant”.

6 On page 19, line 24, after “(1)” insert “Subject to subsection (2) of this
7 section,”.

8 On page 20, line 5, delete “Subject to subsection (2) of this section,”.

9 In line 6, delete “permitted the” and insert “the permitted”.

10 On page 21, line 2, after “Must” insert “, until January 1, 2020,”.

11 In line 4, delete “and” and insert “, and must provide proof that the ap-
12 plicant”.

13 On page 22, line 11, after “Must” insert “, until January 1, 2020,”.

14 In line 13, delete “and” and insert “, and must provide proof that the ap-
15 plicant”.

16 On page 23, line 15, after “Must” insert “, until January 1, 2020,”.

17 In line 17, delete “and” and insert “, and must provide proof that the ap-
18 plicant”.

19 On page 28, delete lines 13 through 20 and insert “Oregon Liquor Control
20 Commission may establish merit-based criteria for licensure or renewal of
21 licensure, including, but not limited to, possession of a developed business
22 plan, access to sufficient capital, offering living wages and benefits to em-

1 ployees, provision of training and apprenticeship, provision of community
2 benefits, implementation of best environmental practices and implementation
3 of consumer safety practices.”.

4 On page 34, line 2, delete “shall” and insert “may”.

5 On page 39, line 4, delete “marijuana”.

6 In line 5, delete “retailer” and insert “person” and delete “section 22,”
7 and insert “section 19, 20, 21 or 22,”.

8 In line 11, delete “section 22,” and insert “section 19, 20, 21 or 22,”.

9 In line 16, delete “section 22,” and insert “section 19, 20, 21 or 22,”.

10 On page 45, line 7, delete “one ounce” and insert “16 ounces”.

11 In line 19, delete “one ounce” and insert “16 ounces”.

12 On page 82, line 17, after “(2)” delete the rest of the line.

13 In line 18, delete “1, Oregon Laws 2015,”.

14 In line 25, after “2015,” insert “, including section 59, chapter 1, Oregon
15 Laws 2015, and section 34 of this 2015 Act,”.

16 On page 83, delete lines 7 through 30.

17 On page 84, delete line 1 and insert:

18 “(4) A person responsible for a marijuana grow site that holds a license
19 under section 19, chapter 1, Oregon Laws 2015:

20 “(a) May not possess more than the amount or number of marijuana
21 plants permitted pursuant to ORS 475.300 to 475.346;

22 “(b) Must allow each marijuana plant to be tracked using the system de-
23 veloped and maintained under section 23 of this 2015 Act;

24 “(c) May sell immature marijuana plants and usable marijuana in excess
25 of amounts produced for individuals who hold a registry identification card
26 issued under ORS 475.309 to a person who holds a license under section 20,
27 21 or 22, chapter 1, Oregon Laws 2015, in accordance with rules adopted by
28 the commission; and

29 “(d) May transfer marijuana and usable marijuana to other registrants
30 under ORS 475.300 to 475.346 in accordance with rules adopted by the au-

1 thority.

2 “(5) In a form and manner prescribed by the commission, a person re-
3 sponsible for a marijuana grow site that holds a license under section 19,
4 chapter 1, Oregon Laws 2015, may surrender the person’s license. If the per-
5 son surrender’s the person’s license, the person is no longer subject to the
6 provisions of this section.”.

7 On page 86, line 25, delete “C felony” and insert “A misdemeanor”.

8 On page 87, line 8, delete “B” and insert “C”.

9 On page 89, line 2, after “form” insert “or cannabinoid concentrates”.

10 In line 5, after “extracts” insert a period.

11 Delete line 6.

12 On page 97, line 28, delete “FORCES” and insert “FORCE”.

13 On page 98, delete lines 1 through 18 and insert:

14 **“SECTION 132.** (1)(a) The Task Force on Cannabis Environmental Best
15 Practices is established, consisting of 13 members appointed as follows:

16 “(A) The President of the Senate shall appoint one member from among
17 members of the Senate;

18 “(B) The Senate Minority Leader shall appoint one member from among
19 members of the Senate;

20 “(C) The Speaker of the House shall appoint one members from among
21 members of the House of Representatives;

22 “(D) The House Minority Leader shall appoint one member from among
23 members of the House of Representatives; and

24 “(E) The Governor shall appoint nine representatives from among the
25 following:

26 “(i) One individual who represents utilities;

27 “(ii) One individual who represents electricians;

28 “(iii) Two individuals who represent the cannabis industry;

29 “(iv) One individual who represents the State Department of Agriculture;

30 “(v) One individual who represents the Water Resources Department;

1 “(vi) One individual who represents the Public Utility Commission;
2 “(vii) One individual who represents the State Department of Energy; and
3 “(viii) One individual who the Energy Trust of Oregon.

4 “(b) In making appointments under paragraph (a) of this subsection, the
5 President of the Senate, the Senate Minority Leader, the Speaker of the
6 House and the House Minority Leader shall appoint, if available, members
7 of the Senate and members of the House of Representatives who served on
8 the Joint Committee on Implementing Measure 91 during the 2015 regular
9 session of the Legislative Assembly.”.

11 On page 101, delete lines 1 through 28.

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
