

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 5036**

1 Delete lines 4 through 25 of the printed bill and insert:

2 **“SECTION 1. There are appropriated to the Secretary of State, for**
3 **the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, out of the General Fund, the**
4 **following amounts, for the following purposes:**

- 5 (1) Administrative Services
6 Division \$ 1,805,142
7 (2) Elections Division \$ 7,322,797
8 (3) Elections Division -
9 Distribution to counties \$ 384,000

10 **“SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**
11 **the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July**
12 **1, 2015, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses from fees,**
13 **moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-**
14 **cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the**
15 **Secretary of State, for the following purposes:**

- 16 (1) Administrative Services
17 Division \$ 16,648,868
18 (2) Elections Division \$ 1,145,964
19 (3) Audits Division..... \$ 19,982,499
20 (4) Archives Division..... \$ 7,626,702
21 (5) Corporation Division \$ 9,364,191

22 **“SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**

1 the amount of \$6,251,910 is established for the biennium beginning July
2 1, 2015, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from federal
3 funds collected or received by the Secretary of State.

4 **“SECTION 4. (1) In addition to and not in lieu of any other appro-**
5 **priation, there is appropriated to the Emergency Board, for the**
6 **biennium beginning July 1, 2015, out of the General Fund, the amount**
7 **of \$384,000, to be allocated to the Secretary of State for payments to**
8 **counties for the costs associated with maintaining voter registration**
9 **records pursuant to chapter 8, Oregon Laws 2015 (Enrolled House Bill**
10 **2177).**

11 **“(2) If any of the moneys appropriated by subsection (1) of this**
12 **section are not allocated by the Emergency Board prior to December**
13 **1, 2016, the moneys remaining on that date become available for any**
14 **purpose for which the Emergency Board lawfully may allocate funds.**

15 **“SECTION 5. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate**
16 **preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is**
17 **declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect July 1, 2015.”.**
