"<u>SECTION 1.</u> Notwithstanding ORS 419A.262 (2)(a), a person is eligible for an order of expunction under ORS 419A.262 if the person was
adjudicated for committing an act that, if committed by an adult,
would constitute a criminal offense in which possession, delivery or
manufacture of marijuana is an element and:

9 "(1) The court finds that at least one year has elapsed since the date
10 of the person's most recent termination;

"(2) The applicant has not been adjudicated or convicted for any
 other act or offense, excluding motor vehicle violations; and

"(3) The applicant has complied with and performed all conditions
 of the adjudication.

15 "SECTION 2. Notwithstanding ORS 137.225 (1)(a), a defendant is el-16 igible for an order setting aside a conviction for a criminal offense in 17 which possession, delivery or manufacture of marijuana is an element 18 after one year has elapsed from the date of entry of judgment of con-19 viction if:

20 "(1) The defendant was under 21 years of age at the time of the 21 conviction;

22 "(2) The defendant has not been convicted of any other offense,

1 excluding motor vehicle violations; and

"(3) The defendant has fully complied with and performed the sentence of the court.".
