PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 460

1 Delete lines 4 through 19 of the printed bill and insert:

² "<u>SECTION 1.</u> Section 2 of this 2015 Act is added to and made a part

3 of ORS 475.300 to 475.346.

4 "<u>SECTION 2.</u> (1) As used in this section:

5 "(a) 'Limited marijuana retail product' means:

6 "(A) The seeds of marijuana;

7 "(B) The dried leaves and flowers of marijuana; and

8 "(C) A marijuana plant that is not flowering.

9 "(b) 'Marijuana' means the plant Cannabis family Cannabaceae, any
10 part of the plant Cannabis family Cannabaceae and the seeds of the
11 plant Cannabis family Cannabaceae.

"(c) 'Medical marijuana dispensary' means an entity registered with
 the Oregon Health Authority under ORS 475.314.

"(2) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, on and after Sep tember 1, 2015, a medical marijuana dispensary may sell limited
 marijuana retail product to a person who is 21 years of age or older
 if:

"(a) The person presents proof of age to the medical marijuana
 dispensary before entering into the medical marijuana dispensary;

"(b) The medical marijuana dispensary verifies that the person is
21 years of age or older at the time of the sale;

22 "(c) The medical marijuana dispensary sells no more than one-

quarter ounce of limited marijuana retail product to the person per
 day if the person is purchasing the dried leaves and flowers of
 marijuana; and

"(d) The medical marijuana dispensary sells no more than four
units of limited marijuana retail product to the person if the person
is purchasing a marijuana plant that is not flowering.

"(3) A city or county may adopt ordinances prohibiting the sale of
limited marijuana retail product as described in this section in the
area subject to the jurisdiction of the city or the unincorporated area
subject to the jurisdiction of the county.

"SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2015 Act is repealed on December 31,
 2016.

"<u>SECTION 4.</u> This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate
 preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is
 declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect on its passage.".
