

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
A-ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL 2642**

1 On page 4 of the printed A-engrossed bill, delete lines 8 through 11 and
2 insert:

3 “(c) Requiring a certified advanced esthetician to enter into an agreement
4 with:

5 “(A) A physician licensed under ORS chapter 677 or a nurse practitioner
6 licensed under ORS 678.375 to 678.390; or

7 “(B) A licensed health care professional who works at the same location
8 as the certified advanced esthetician and who has the authority to prescribe
9 drugs listed in Schedule III, IV or V.

10 “(3) The purpose of an agreement described in subsection (2)(c) of this
11 section is to provide a certified advanced esthetician with a licensed health
12 care professional to whom the certified advanced esthetician may refer a
13 client of the certified advanced esthetician.”

14 On page 6, after line 1, insert:

15 **“SECTION 12. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**
16 **the limitation on expenditures established by section 2, chapter**
17 **_____, Oregon Laws 2015 (Enrolled Senate Bill 5526), for the biennium**
18 **beginning July 1, 2015, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses**
19 **from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Re-**
20 **ceipts, tobacco tax receipts, provider taxes, Medicare receipts and**
21 **federal funds for indirect cost recovery, Supplemental Security Income**
22 **recoveries, Women, Infants and Children Program food rebates, the**

1 **Coordinated School Health Program, the Edward Byrne Memorial**
2 **State and Local Law Enforcement Assistance Grant Program, home-**
3 **land security and emergency preparedness and response services, but**
4 **excluding lottery funds and federal funds not described in section 2,**
5 **chapter _____, Oregon Laws 2015 (Enrolled Senate Bill 5526), collected**
6 **or received by the Oregon Health Authority, is increased by \$386,294**
7 **for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of this 2015 Act.**

8 **“SECTION 13. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**
9 **the amount of \$118,249 is established for the biennium beginning July**
10 **1, 2015, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees,**
11 **moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-**
12 **cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the**
13 **Higher Education Coordinating Commission, for the purpose of carry-**
14 **ing out the provisions of this 2015 Act.”.**

15 In line 2, delete “12” and insert “14”.

16 In line 9, delete “13” and insert “15”.
