

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
SENATE BILL 75**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after the first semicolon delete the
2 rest of the line and delete line 3 and insert “and declaring an emergency.”.

3 Delete lines 5 through 28 and delete pages 2 through 4 and insert:

4 **“SECTION 1. (1) The Task Force on Campaign Finance Reform is**
5 **established, consisting of eight voting members and one nonvoting**
6 **member as follows:**

7 **“(a) The Secretary of State shall appoint the following voting**
8 **members:**

9 **“(A) Three members, appointed so that one member represents the**
10 **interests of each of the three major political parties in Oregon.**

11 **“(B) One member to represent the interests of minor political par-**
12 **ties in Oregon.**

13 **“(b) The Secretary of State shall serve as a nonvoting member of**
14 **the task force.**

15 **“(c) The President of the Senate shall appoint two voting members**
16 **from among members of the Senate, one of whom is a Democrat and**
17 **one of whom is a Republican.**

18 **“(d) The Speaker of the House of Representatives shall appoint two**
19 **voting members from among members of the House of Represen-**
20 **tatives, one of whom is a Democrat and one of whom is a Republican.**

21 **“(2) The task force shall conduct an analysis and determine the best**
22 **method or methods to address campaign finance reforms.**

1 **“(3) A majority of the voting members of the task force constitutes**
2 **a quorum for the transaction of business.**

3 **“(4) Official action by the task force requires the approval of a**
4 **majority of the voting members of the task force.**

5 **“(5) The task force shall elect one of its members to serve as**
6 **chairperson.**

7 **“(6) If there is a vacancy for any cause, the appointing authority**
8 **shall make an appointment to become immediately effective.**

9 **“(7) The task force shall meet at times and places specified by the**
10 **call of the chairperson or of a majority of the voting members of the**
11 **task force.**

12 **“(8) The task force may adopt rules necessary for the operation of**
13 **the task force.**

14 **“(9) The task force shall submit a report in the manner provided**
15 **by ORS 192.245, and may include recommendations for legislation, to**
16 **the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to rules**
17 **no later than December 31, 2015.**

18 **“(10) The staff of the Committee Services Office of the Legislative**
19 **Administration Committee shall provide staff support to the task**
20 **force.**

21 **“(11) Members of the task force who are not members of the Leg-**
22 **islative Assembly are not entitled to compensation, but may be reim-**
23 **bursed for actual and necessary travel and other expenses incurred by**
24 **them in the performance of their official duties in the manner and**
25 **amounts provided for in ORS 292.495. Claims for expenses incurred in**
26 **performing functions of the task force shall be paid out of funds ap-**
27 **propriated to the Legislative Assembly for purposes of the task force.**

28 **“(12) All agencies of state government, as defined in ORS 174.111,**
29 **are directed to assist the task force in the performance of its duties**
30 **and, to the extent permitted by laws relating to confidentiality, to**

1 furnish such information and advice as the members of the task force
2 consider necessary to perform their duties.

3 **“SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2015 Act is repealed on July 2, 2017.**

4 **“SECTION 3. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate
5 preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is
6 declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect on its passage.”.**

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
