Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, 22

the amount of \$6,251,910 is established for the biennium beginning July
1, 2015, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from federal
funds collected or received by the Secretary of State.

"SECTION 4. (1) In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Emergency Board, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$384,000, to be allocated to the Secretary of State for payments to counties for the costs associated with maintaining voter registration precords pursuant to chapter 8, Oregon Laws 2015 (Enrolled House Bill 2177).

"(2) If any of the moneys appropriated by subsection (1) of this
section are not allocated by the Emergency Board prior to December
1, 2016, the moneys remaining on that date become available for any
purpose for which the Emergency Board lawfully may allocate funds.
"<u>SECTION 5.</u> This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate
preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is
declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect July 1, 2015.".
