 - "(3) The purpose of an agreement described in subsection (2)(c) of this section is to provide a certified advanced esthetician with a licensed health care professional to whom the certified advanced esthetician may refer a client of the certified advanced esthetician.".

- moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-
- 12 cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the
- 13 Higher Education Coordinating Commission, for the purpose of carry-
- ing out the provisions of this 2015 Act.".

- In line 9, delete "13" and insert "15".
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
