17 **the amount of \$311,267,945 is established for a six-year period beginning**  
18 **July 1, 2015, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees,**  
19 **moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and re-**  
20 **imbursements from federal service agreements, but excluding lottery**  
21 **funds and federal funds not described in this section, collected or re-**  
22 **ceived by the Higher Education Coordinating Commission, for ex-**  
23 **penditures of proceeds from state bonds issued for the benefit of a**  
24 **public university, pursuant to agreements between the commission**  
25 **and a public university.**

26 **“SECTION 4. The project approvals and expenditure limitations in**  
27 **sections 1, 2 and 3 of this 2015 Act expire on June 30, 2021, unless**  
28 **otherwise noted.**

23       **SECTION 7. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**  
24 **the amount of \$2,082,893 is established for a six-year period beginning**  
25 **July 1, 2013, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees,**  
26 **moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and fed-**  
27 **eral funds, but excluding lottery funds, collected or received by the**  
28 **Oregon Military Department, for the acquisition of land and the ac-**  
29 **quisition, planning, constructing, altering, repairing, furnishing and**  
30 **equipping of the Oregon Military Museum.**



1        **“SECTION 8. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate**  
2 **preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is**  
3 **declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect on July 1, 2015.”.**

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
