PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO B-ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL 3396

1 On <u>page 1</u> of the printed B-engrossed bill, line 2, after "ORS" insert 2 "315.613,".

3 Delete line 5 and insert "and prescribing an effective date.".

4 On page 4, after line 45, insert:

5 "SECTION 7a. ORS 315.613, as amended by section 19, chapter ____, 6 Oregon Laws 2015 (Enrolled House Bill 2171), is amended to read:

"315.613. (1) A resident or nonresident individual certified as eligible un-7 der ORS 442.563, licensed under ORS chapter 677, who is engaged in the 8 practice of medicine, and who is engaged for at least 20 hours per week, 9 averaged over the month, during the tax year in a rural practice, shall be 10 allowed an annual credit against taxes otherwise due under ORS chapter 316. 11 "(2) The amount of credit allowed shall be based on the distance, in 12highway miles, from a major population center in a qualified metropolitan 13 statistical area at which the taxpayer maintains a practice or hospital 14 membership: 15

16 "(a) If at least 10 miles but fewer than 20 miles, \$3,000.

"(b) If at least 20 miles but fewer than 50 miles, \$4,000.

18 "(c) If 50 or more miles, \$5,000.

"(3) The credit shall be allowed during the time in which the individual
retains such practice and membership if the individual is actively practicing
in and is a member of the medical staff of one of the following hospitals:
"(a) A type A hospital designated as such by the Office of Rural Health;

1 "(b) A type B hospital designated as such by the Office of Rural Health 2 if the hospital is:

³ "(A) Not within the boundaries of a metropolitan statistical area;

"(B) Located 30 or more highway miles from the closest hospital
within the major population center in a metropolitan statistical area;
or

7 "[(B)] (C) Located in a county with a population of less than 75,000;

8 "(c) A type C rural hospital, if the Office of Rural Health makes the
9 findings required by ORS 315.619;

"(d) A rural hospital that was designated a rural referral center by the federal government before January 1, 1989, and that serves a community with a population of at least 14,000 but not more than 19,000; or

¹³ "(e) A rural critical access hospital.

"(4) In order to claim the credit allowed under this section, the individual 14 must remain willing during the tax year to serve patients with Medicare 15coverage and patients receiving medical assistance in at least the same pro-16 portion to the individual's total number of patients as the Medicare and 17 medical assistance populations represent of the total number of persons de-18 termined by the Office of Rural Health to be in need of care in the county 19 served by the practice, not to exceed 20 percent Medicare patients or 15 20percent medical assistance patients. 21

²² "(5) A nonresident individual shall be allowed the credit under this sec-²³ tion in the proportion provided in ORS 316.117. If a change in the status of ²⁴ a taxpayer from resident to nonresident or from nonresident to resident oc-²⁵ curs, the credit allowed by this section shall be determined in a manner ²⁶ consistent with ORS 316.117.

"(6) For purposes of this section, an 'individual's practice' shall be determined on the basis of actual time spent in practice each week in hours or days, whichever is considered by the Office of Rural Health to be more appropriate. In the case of a shareholder of a corporation or a member of a partnership, only the time of the individual shareholder or partner shall be
considered and the full amount of the credit shall be allowed to each shareholder or partner who qualifies in an individual capacity.

4 "(7) As used in this section:

5 "[(a) 'Type A hospital,' 'type B hospital' and 'type C hospital' have the 6 meaning for those terms provided in ORS 442.470.]

"(a) 'Qualified metropolitan statistical area' means only those
counties of a metropolitan statistical area that are located in Oregon
if the largest city within the metropolitan statistical area is located
in Oregon.

"(b) 'Rural critical access hospital' means a facility that meets the criteria set forth in 42 U.S.C. 1395i-4 (c)(2)(B) and that has been designated a critical access hospital by the Office of Rural Health and the Oregon Health Authority.

"(c) 'Type A hospital,' 'type B hospital' and 'type C hospital' have
 the meaning for those terms provided in ORS 442.470.

"SECTION 7b. The amendments to ORS 315.613 by section 7a of this
2015 Act apply to tax years beginning on or after January 1, 2016.".

19 On page 5, delete lines 30 through 32 and insert:

20 "<u>SECTION 15.</u> This 2015 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the 21 date on which the 2015 regular session of the Seventy-eighth Legisla-22 tive Assembly adjourns sine die.".

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
