

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
SENATE BILL 5507**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after “administration;” insert “cre-
2 ating new provisions; repealing section 7, chapter ___, Oregon Laws 2015
3 (Enrolled Senate Bill 113), sections 19, 20 and 21, chapter 537, Oregon Laws
4 2015 (Enrolled Senate Bill 454), section 17, chapter ___, Oregon Laws 2015
5 (Enrolled Senate Bill 478), section 12, chapter 557, Oregon Laws 2015 (En-
6 rolled House Bill 2960), section 1, chapter ___, Oregon Laws 2015 (Enrolled
7 House Bill 5022), and section 3, chapter ___, Oregon Laws 2015 (Enrolled
8 House Bill 5040);”.

9 Delete lines 4 through 30 and delete page 2 and insert:

10 **“SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the**
11 **General Fund appropriation made to the Secretary of State by section**
12 **1 (2), chapter ___, Oregon Laws 2015 (Enrolled House Bill 5036), for the**
13 **biennium beginning July 1, 2015, for the Elections Division, is de-**
14 **creased by \$768,000 for the expenses of implementing the motor voter**
15 **provisions of chapter 8, Oregon Laws 2015 (Enrolled House Bill 2177).**

16 **“SECTION 2. If Senate Bill 478 becomes law, section 17, chapter ___,**
17 **Oregon Laws 2015 (Enrolled Senate Bill 478), is repealed.**

18 **“SECTION 3. Sections 19, 20 and 21, chapter 537, Oregon Laws 2015**
19 **(Enrolled Senate Bill 454), are repealed.**

20 **“SECTION 4. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the**
21 **General Fund appropriation made to the Department of Environ-**
22 **mental Quality by section 1 (1), chapter 593, Oregon Laws 2015 (En-**

1 rolled House Bill 5018), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, for air
2 quality, is decreased by \$778,141 for expenses of implementing the low
3 carbon fuel standards under chapter 4, Oregon Laws 2015 (Enrolled
4 Senate Bill 324).

5 **“SECTION 5.** Section 12, chapter 557, Oregon Laws 2015 (Enrolled
6 House Bill 2960), is repealed.

7 **“SECTION 6.** Section 7, chapter ___, Oregon Laws 2015 (Enrolled
8 Senate Bill 113), is repealed.

9 **“SECTION 7.** Section 1, chapter ___, Oregon Laws 2015 (Enrolled
10 House Bill 5022), is repealed.

11 **“SECTION 8.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the
12 General Fund appropriation made to the Department of Human Ser-
13 vices by section 1 (1), chapter ___, Oregon Laws 2015 (Enrolled House
14 Bill 5026), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, is decreased by
15 \$831,865 for the expenses of implementing the REAL+D project to de-
16 sign, build and implement a tool to collect, report and analyze data
17 on race, ethnicity, language and disability.

18 **“SECTION 9.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the
19 General Fund appropriation made to the Oregon Health Authority by
20 section 1 (1), chapter ___, Oregon Laws 2015 (Enrolled Senate Bill 5526),
21 for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, is decreased by \$634,672 for
22 expenses of implementing the REAL+D project to design, build and
23 implement a tool to collect, report and analyze data on race, ethnicity,
24 language and disability.

25 **“SECTION 10.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the
26 General Fund appropriation made to the State Library by section 1,
27 chapter 407, Oregon Laws 2015 (Enrolled Senate Bill 5519), for the
28 biennium beginning July 1, 2015, is decreased by \$4,602,951 for the State
29 Library Government Research and Electronic Service Program.

30 **“SECTION 11.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the

1 General Fund appropriation made to the Department of Justice by
2 section 1 (2), chapter ___, Oregon Laws 2015 (Enrolled Senate Bill 5516),
3 for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, for the Civil Enforcement
4 Division, is decreased by \$2,000,000 for the Cover Oregon litigation.

5 **“SECTION 12.** Section 3, chapter ___, Oregon Laws 2015 (Enrolled
6 House Bill 5040), is repealed.

7 **“SECTION 13.** (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the
8 General Fund appropriation made to the Department of Environ-
9 mental Quality by section 1 (1), chapter 593, Oregon Laws 2015 (En-
10 rolled House Bill 5018), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, for air
11 quality, is decreased by \$361,563 for extending an air toxics study on
12 Swan Island.

13 **“(2)** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund
14 appropriation made to the Department of Environmental Quality by
15 section 1 (2), chapter 593, Oregon Laws 2015 (Enrolled House Bill 5018),
16 for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, for water quality, is decreased
17 by \$452,719 for a new wastewater permitting software module to re-
18 place the current system.

19 **“(3)** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund
20 appropriation made to the Department of Environmental Quality by
21 section 1 (2), chapter 593, Oregon Laws 2015 (Enrolled House Bill 5018),
22 for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, for water quality, is decreased
23 by \$491,435 for water quality assessment.

24 **“(4)** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund
25 appropriation made to the Department of Environmental Quality by
26 section 1 (2), chapter 593, Oregon Laws 2015 (Enrolled House Bill 5018),
27 for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, for water quality, is decreased
28 by \$403,568 for nonpoint source pollution.

29 **“(5)** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund
30 appropriation made to the Department of Environmental Quality by

1 section 1 (3), chapter 593, Oregon Laws 2015 (Enrolled House Bill 5018),
2 for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, for land quality, is decreased
3 by \$675,849 for the promotion and enhancement of waste reduction and
4 recycling.

5 “(6) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund
6 appropriation made to the Department of Environmental Quality by
7 section 1 (2), chapter 593, Oregon Laws 2015 (Enrolled House Bill 5018),
8 for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, for water quality, is decreased
9 by \$1,098,213 for management reforms.

10 “SECTION 14. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the
11 General Fund appropriation made to the Oregon Department of Ad-
12 ministrative Services by section 1 (4), chapter __, Oregon Laws 2015
13 (Enrolled Senate Bill 5502), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, is
14 decreased by \$375,000 for the Oregon Historical Society.

15 “SECTION 15. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the
16 General Fund appropriation made to the Department of Education by
17 section 1, chapter 25, Oregon Laws 2015 (Enrolled House Bill 5017), for
18 the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, for the State School Fund, is in-
19 creased by \$32,682,317.

20 “SECTION 16. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate
21 preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is
22 declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect July 1, 2015.”.

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
