HB 4058

Permits corporation with shares that are registered under securities law of this state or under federal securities law to reject vote, consent, waiver or proxy authorization if shareholder has not complied with public disclosure requirements of securities law of this state or federal securities law.

HB 4065 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 2/4/2016 AGENDA: Requires contracting agency to determine whether contractor appears on list of liquidated or delinquent accounts that state agencies assign for collection or failed to make payment for more than 90 days on liquidated or delinquent account that state agency has not assigned for collection.

Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

HB 4138

Authorizes Legislative Assembly to request appointment of independent counsel by joint resolution.

HB 4106

Prohibits state agency from relying only upon expediency, convenience, best interest of public, general public need or speculation as basis for finding of prejudice that authorizes temporary adoption, amendment or suspension of rule.

HB 4122

Allows local government to inhibit or prevent production or use of seed or seed products for purpose of protecting seed or products that are not genetically engineered from adverse impacts of genetically engineered seed or products.

HB 4090

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 2/4/2016 AGENDA: Prohibits declaration or bylaws of planned community or condominium from requiring owners to water or irrigate lawns, gardens or other landscaped areas.

HB 4041

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 2/4/2016 AGENDA: Removes products of seed from statute prohibiting local governments from inhibiting or preventing production of seed.
