#### Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- HB 4036 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Requires each electric company providing electricity to retail electricity consumers located in this state to eliminate coal-fired resources from electric company's electricity supply.
- HB 4037 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Directs Oregon Business Development Department to establish program to incentivize generation of electricity derived from solar energy.
- HB 4101 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Requires Environmental Quality Commission to adopt by rule program for assessing net impacts of state policies and programs for reducing greenhouse gas emissions.
- HB 4125 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Requires Oregon Health Authority to analyze ground water contaminant data and provide education in areas with ground water contaminant problems.
