- SB 1550 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
CARRIED OVER FROM 2/9/2016 AGENDA: Directs presiding judges of judicial districts within state to ensure proceedings before grand jury are recorded.
- SB 1553
CARRIED OVER FROM 2/9/2016 AGENDA: Authorizes prosecution of first-degree sex crimes any time after commission of crime if prosecuting attorney obtains corroborating evidence of crime.
- SB 1555
CARRIED OVER FROM 2/9/2016 AGENDA: Allows polygraph test as condition of employment for preemployment screening of law enforcement officers.
- SB 1571 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
CARRIED OVER FROM 2/9/2016 AGENDA: Directs Department of State Police to adopt rules concerning prioritization of testing untested sexual assault forensic evidence kits.
