**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:** Includes agreeing to receive goods, services, or something else of value derived from prostitution activity in crime of promoting prostitution.

**ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

**EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:** No amendment.

**BACKGROUND:** Under current law, a person commits the crime of promoting prostitution if a person knowingly owns or maintains a place of prostitution, induces or causes a person to engage in prostitution or remain in a place of prostitution, or receives or agrees to receive money or property derived from prostitution, other than compensation to the prostitute. Promoting prostitution is a Class C Felony. ORS 167.012.

House Bill 4082 adds new language to what a person may receive or agree to receive that is derived from prostitution. The measure includes goods, services, or something else of value as a thing that may be received and derived from prostitution.
