**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:**

Creates short-term grant program to be developed and administered by the Office of Emergency Management in consultation with the Oregon Department of Transportation, to permit withdrawal of fuel by specified personnel from certain fuel storage facilities in an emergency. Limits each grant to \$4,000 per facility. Limits total grants fund to \$100,000. Sunsets June 30, 2022. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

*[-1 amendment]*: Requires Fire Marshall to check installation of connectors financed by grant funds, as part of existing annual inspections already performed.
