## Oregon needs to act now to put a price on carbon and begin investing in a fossil free future.

We can once again be a national leader in addressing the climate crisis. The Healthy Climate Act will help us smooth the way into the **Great Transition** needed to achieve a fossil free future.

It is critical that this bill be passed as it will:

Force **polluters to pay.** I heartily endorse establishing a "carbon pollution market" in which "carbon allowances" will be auctioned to the polluters. This mechanism will allow the state to ratcheted down greenhouse gas emissions to achieve our long term goals so that greenhouse gas emission will be at least 75% below 1990 levels. oCalifornia has demonstrated with this polluter pay approach that you can grow your economy and create jobs while reducing CO2 emissions.
