

FISCAL IMPACT OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION

Measure Description:

Requires Office of Emergency Management to develop and administer grant program for purpose of installing connectors at certain fuel storage facilities that are compatible with generators used by emergency response personnel.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Oregon Military Department, Oregon State Police (OSP)

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis:

The measure establishes the Fuel Storage Facility Compatibility Fund, separate and distinct from the General Fund, and credits interest earned back to the fund. The fund is to consist of monies deposited from any source and is continuously appropriated to the Office of Emergency Management (OEM). The purpose of the fund is to provide a grant program for the installation of generator connectors on fuel sources at cardlock facilities in Oregon.

OEM is to establish application criteria and standards for qualification. The grants may not exceed \$4,000 per cardlock facility and the total amount of grants issued may not exceed \$100,000.

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Veterans and Emergency Preparedness to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
