Measure Description:

Directs Office of Student Access and Completion to provide support services to enable students to be successful in Oregon Promise program.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Higher Education Coordinating Commission

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Higher Education, Innovation, and Workforce Development to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The bill redistributes Higher Education Coordinating Commission (HECC) funding, in the amount of \$2,500,000 General Fund, to be distributed equitably among the community colleges for the purpose of providing support services to enable students to be successful in the Oregon Promise program.

Each community college is directed to report to the HECC, no later than November 31, 2016, regarding the use of the moneys received. The HECC is required to submit a report that summarizes the distributions made to community colleges, no later than December 31, 2016, to the interim legislative committees on education.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
