Dear Chair McKeown and House Committee on Transportation and Economic Development:

I write to urge you to pass the Transit Expansion Fund bill, HB 4078. This legislation is urgently needed and, as you know, has wide bipartisan support. Too often small urban and rural districts get lost in the shuffle of our big transportation bills and this is a great reason to get this piece passed this session. Moreover, too many of our small districts desperately need this funding source sooner than later and thus, passage this session gets us to rulemaking sooner.
