### WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Requires financial institutions to develop data match agreements with the Department of Revenue. The purpose of these agreements is too conduct quarterly matches to identify assets held by delinquent debtors. The bill also allows the Department of Revenue to enter into agreements with the Department of Justice's Division of Child Support to access employer data on newly hired workers. Finally the bill creates criminal provisions for misuse of matched data.

### **BACKGROUND:**
