This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15. Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis:

The bill, as amended by the -1 amendment, extends the current dispute resolution process for the Construction Contractors Board (CCB) from July 1, 2017 to July 1, 2018. There is no fiscal impact in the 2015-17 biennium as the process and its associated costs are still assumed in the agency budget for the current biennium. Extending the current dispute resolution process to July 1, 2018 will have an estimated cost of \$550,000 Other Funds for Office of Administrative Hearings expenses in the 2017-19 biennium.
