**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:** Requires all statewide elected officials and state agency or commission directors to identify lead staff or staff that reports directly them by each February 1. Those identified must file statement of economic interest with Oregon Government Ethics Commission.

**ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

**EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:** No amendment.

**BACKGROUND:** ORS 244.050 specifies public officials who are required to file annual statements of economic interest with the Oregon Government Ethics Commission (OGEC). The information public officials are required to report on a statement of economic interest includes: all expenses with an aggregate value exceeding \$50 received while participating in a convention, mission, or negotiation of economic development; all honoraria and other items exceeding a value of \$15; and each source of income exceeding \$1,000, if the source of income is derived from an individual or business that has or could have legislative or administrative interests.
