**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:**

Requires each public university to report to Legislative Assembly detailed list of all university expenditures on state programs.

**ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

**EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:**

No amendment.

**BACKGROUND:**

Several programs currently operating at Oregon's public universities address economic development, natural resource management or similar issues as opposed to providing for the instruction and support of students. Examples include: Labor Education and Research Center at the University of Oregon; the Fermentation Science Program at Oregon State University; and the Portland State University Population Research Center. House Bill 4010 requires universities to submit annual reports to the Legislative Assembly detailing and categorizing expenditures on such programs. The first report must be submitted not later than July 1, 2017.
